

Adjectives of 3rd declension



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- three forms in nominative singular:
 - *ācer*, *ācris*, *ācre* (*celer*, *celeris*, *celere*)
 - each gender has its own form in nom. sg.
- two forms in nominative singular:
 - *nāsālis*, *nāsale*
 - masculines and feminines have the same form in nom. sg.
- one form in nominative singular:
 - *simplex*, *simplicis*
 - all three genders have the same form in nom. sg
 - it is important to know also their genitive ending (in the dictionary)

- it is important to know all the forms given in the dictionary

Adjektiva 3. deklinace



- masculine and feminine gender forms are declined according to paradigm *pelvis*
 - !but abl. sg.: *-ī*
- neuters according to paradigm *rete*
