-SCOPIA: visual examination of the interior of a body organ, broadly also any inspection of a body part

e. g. endoscopia: examination of the inside of the body

Inspection of FETUS- Fet-o-scopia

Inspection of PHARYNX- Pharyng-o-scopia

Inspection of ANUS- An-o-scopia

Inspection of ABDOMINAL CAVITY- Lapar-o-scopia

Inspection of LARGE INTESTINE- Col-o(no)-scopia

Inspection of THORACIC CAVITY- Thorac-o-scopia

Inspection of VAGINA- Colp-o-scopia

Inspection of EYE- **Ophthalm-o-scopia**




