A student prepares the presentation – audio Slide show – which has 2 parts:

- a) Brief case report of the patient (any field is acceptable)
- b) Characteristics of the disease.

c) pronunciation and comprehensibility: scale 1-10 points

- 1 almost incomprehensible, pronunciation influenced by a foreign language
- 5 fully comprehensible, less frequent deficiencies in pronunciation
- 10 perfect/natural pronunciation and comprehensibility

The student will communicate everything necessary in an oral commentary, which is the main part of the presentation. The student will speak "in his own words". He will use language understood by fellow Czech non-native speakers and the non-professional public. <u>Presentations that contain copied passages from Wikipedia or Google will not be accepted</u>. The presentation will have the usual structure: address, introduction, case report, illness, conclusion and thanks.
