1. _____ system – the system that carries blood to various parts of the body. It is also called circulatory.
2. _____ system – all the organs and glands involved in the ingestion and digestion of food.
3. _____ system – the ductless gland that produce internal secretions and secrete these directly into the blood or lymph and circulates it to all body parts.
4. _____ system – the skin (the largest organ in the body) and its associated structures.
5. _____ system – a system of nerve cells. It regulates and co-ordinates bodily activities and enables the body to adjust to external and internal changes.
6. _____ system – the system that enables human beings to have offspring.
7. _____ system – the system that brings oxygen into the body and removes carbon dioxide. This process, called breathing, involves two acts: inspiration and expiration.
8. _____ system – the system that protects and supports the internal organs and also helps the body move. The skeleton has 206 named bones. Surrounding the bones and soft organs of the body are more than 605 muscles.
9. _____ system – the system that removes urea and other waste materials from the body in a liquid called urine.
