<b>pregnancy</b>	<b>a situation/state for a woman when there develops a baby or more babies inside her belly</b>
<b>postpartum</b>	<b>also called puerperium, six weeks following a childbirth</b>
<b>fetus</b>	<b>name for a human being between month 2 to 9 before a birth</b>
<b>cervix</b>	<b>an entrance to the uterus</b>
<b>Ceasarian section</b>	<b>an operational birth</b>
<b>LMP</b>	<b>last menstrual period</b>
<b>PMT</b>	<b>pre-menstrual tension</b>
<b>ovulation</b>	<b>a moment when the egg (ovum) leaves an ovary</b>
<b>rely on somebody</b>	<b>trust to somebody because they are responsible and help you when you need it</b>
<b>excellent</b>	<b>very very good</b>
<b>provide</b>	<b>to supply or give or deliver something</b>
<b>occur</b>	<b>to appear, exist, happen (objevit se, stat se)</b>
<b>Fallopian tubes</b>	<b>oviducts, two tubes which connect ovaries and the uterus</b>

<b>joint</b>	<b>a place of the connection or articulation of two bones</b>
<b>innominate bone</b>	<b>one of the hip bones which consists of the ischium, ilium and pubis</b>
<b>bottom</b>	<b>opposite of “top”</b>
<b>layer</b>	<b>a level or a part within a system</b>
<b>sphincter</b>	<b>a round muscle which helps to close some opening</b>
<b>sexual intercourse</b>	<b>an action of penis when it penetrates the vagina</b>
<b>orifice</b>	<b>an opening or entrance</b>
<b>glands</b>	<b>an organ in a person’s or an animal’s body that produces a substance for the body to use</b>
<b>egg</b>	<b>ovum</b>
<b>ligament</b>	<b>a strong group of tissues in the body that connects bones and supports organs and keeps them in position</b>
<b>to fertilize</b>	<b>to join SPERM with an egg so that a baby or young animal develops</b>
<b>to attach</b>	<b>to join one thing to another, to connect two things together</b>
