

## HOSPITAL

1. \_\_\_\_\_ a building, often large, where injured or ill people are looked after by doctors and nurses.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ a building where people who need not stay in hospital get special medical treatment or advice.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ a place where several doctors have their surgeries and people visit them if they have a health problem.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ a place where old and ill people live and are looked after.
5. \_\_\_\_\_ a hospital for terminally ill patients.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ a hospital where people are looked after, often those who are disabled or mentally ill.
7. \_\_\_\_\_ a facility that treats people with mental problems/problems with drugs/alcohol.
8. \_\_\_\_\_ a special hospital for patients suffering or recovering from a long-term disease.
9. \_\_\_\_\_ often used with names of hospitals.
