

## MEDICAL SPECIALISTS

<b>Allergist:</b>	helps in treating different kinds of allergies and immune system disorders like hay fever, asthma, etc.
<b>Cardiologist:</b>	treats heart diseases and cardiovascular diseases.
<b>Dentist:</b>	deals with teeth and dental problems like cavities and bleeding gums.
<b>Dermatologists:</b>	studies the skin, its structure, functions, and diseases, as well as its appendages (nails, hair, sweat glands) and treats the related ailments.
<b>Endocrinologists:</b>	studies disorders of the endocrine system and their glands.
<b>Family Practitioner:</b>	this is your friendly neighbourhood doctors who are basically general physicians, and treat patients of all ages & medical non-emergency conditions usually in a clinic.
<b>Gastroenterologists:</b>	studies diseases of digestive system
<b>Gynecologists:</b>	studies and treats diseases of the female reproductive system.
<b>Hematologists:</b>	studies blood and its diseases.
<b>Hepatologists:</b>	treats diseases of the liver.
<b>Immunologists:</b>	studies all aspects of the immune system in all organisms and gives treatment to diseases of the immune system.
<b>Internist:</b>	focuses on adult medicine and have completed a special study related to the prevention and treatment of adult diseases.
<b>Neonatologist:</b>	provides medical care to premature and critically ill newborn babies.
<b>Nephrologist:</b>	treats kidney diseases and problems.
<b>Neurologist:</b>	treats the brain and its conditions like seizures, strokes, Parkinson's, Alzheimer's, etc.
<b>Obstetrician:</b>	This is a part of gynaecology and the doctors are experts with childbirth, C-sections, gynaecological surgeries, prenatal care, etc.
<b>Oncologist:</b>	treats cancer patients.
<b>Ophthalmologist:</b>	takes care of eyes and treats various eye problems and performs different eye surgeries.
<b>ENT specialists:</b>	treats the <b>E</b> ar, the <b>N</b> ose and the <b>T</b> hroat, as well as to some extent some ailments of the head and the neck..
<b>Pediatricians:</b>	studies and treats medical problems of infants, children, and adolescents.
<b>Physiatrist:</b>	the doctor whose specialty is medicine and rehabilitation.
<b>Podiatrists:</b>	the doctor who studies and treats disorders of the foot and ankle.
<b>Psychiatrists:</b>	specializes in the study, diagnoses and treatment of mental illness and behavioural disorders.
<b>Pulmonologist:</b>	diagnoses and treats lung conditions and treatments and even manages critical care patients admitted in the ICU and those that are on ventilator support.
<b>Radiologist:</b>	carries out the study of medical use of X-rays or other imaging technologies for diagnoses and treatment of disease.
<b>Rheumatologist:</b>	treats allergic conditions & autoimmune disorders.
<b>Surgeons:</b>	performs operations
<b>Urologists:</b>	studies the urinary system and treats urinary tract infections.
