

Latin nouns of 4th and 5th declensions



4th DECLENSION (U-STEMS)

1) **Masculines**: ductus, ūs, m.

e.g. effectus – effectūs, situs – sitūs

EXCEPTIONS: manus, ūs, f.; acus, ūs, f.

2) **Neuters**: genū, ūs, n.

e.g. cornū – cornūs

5th DECLENSION (Ē-STEMS)

Feminines: faciēs, ēī, f.

rabiēs – rabiēī; rēs – reī

EXCEPTION: diēs, ēī, m.

speciēs (sg., pl.) – species: speciēs nova, speciēs novae

speciēs (pl.) – tea: speciēs urologicae
