Latus (dexter, a, um)

latus dextrum, lateris dextri, latus dextrum, latere dextro; (plural is not used)

Morbus (acutus, a, um)

morbus acutus, morbi acuti, morbum acutum, morbo acuto, morbi acuti, morborum acutorum, morbos acutos, morbis acutis

Regio (parvus, a, um)

regio parva, regionis parvae, regionem parvam, regione parva, regiones parvae, regionum parvarum, regiones parvas, regionibus parvis

Margo (liber, a, um)

margo liber, marginis liberi, marginem liberum, margine libero, margines liberi, marginum liberorum, margines liberos, marginibus liberis
