

CREATING ADJECTIVES FROM NOUNS

How?

GENITIVE STEM + ADJ. SUFFIX

A) Adjectives of 1st/2nd declension

using *suffixes*:

-*eus*, a, um -*inus*, a, um -*ivus*, a, um

-*icus*, a, um -*arius*, a, um -*itus*, a, um

Declining like: masculines – NERVUS // feminines – VENA // neuters – SEPTUM

B) Adjectives of 3rd declension

Using *suffixes*: -*alis, e* M+F:-*alis*

-*aris, e* *if there is -*l-* before N: -*e*

Compare: English **-al/-ar**

Declining like: masculines + feminines – PELVIS BUT! Abl. Sg.: **-i**


neuters – RETE
