- 3. What condition is CAD caused by? atherosclerosis (the gradual build-up of plaque in the blood vessels/coronary arteries)
- 4. What is plaque made of? fat, cholesterol, calcium, and other cellular matter
- 5. What condition results when the blood flow is restricted? angina, chest pain
- 6. How is the pain during heart attack often described? crushing or squeezing pressure in the chest
- 7. Which races are at a greater risk? Hispanics, African Americans, American Indians, some Asian Americans
- 8. What conditions contribute to developing CAD? cholesterol, high blood pressure, diabetes
- 9. Which lifestyle choices put people more at risk of developing CAD? smoking, poor diet, inactivity, weight gain
