2. Reading: Hypertension

- 1. Hypertension (HT) is commonly called high blood pressure and it is defined as above 140 over 85 mm of mercury (Hg). In case the patient is diabetic values higher than 135/80 are considered to be HT.
- 2. Correct treatment of hypertension reduces the risk of a heart attack by about 20% and the risk of stroke by about 40%.
- 3. As many as 16 million UK people have high blood pressure
- 4. kidney disease, being obese, too much alcohol, too much salt, strass, lack of exercise, poor diet, too little potassium and family history (whether the disease runs in the family)
- 5. Kidney disease or diabetes are diseases contributing to the development of HT. HT may cause heart diseases and stroke.
