

**Dissection manual – GROUP 2
(from 20.1. (from 1 p.m.) to 22. 1. 2021)**

Back:

Day 1. afternoon: Skin incisions, rr. dorsales nervorum spinalium

Day 2. morning: M. trapezius, m. latissimus dorsi

Day 2. afternoon: M. splenius capitis, mm. rhomboidei, trigonum Petiti et Grynfelti,

Day 3. morning: M. semispinalis capitis, m. serratus posterior superior, m. erector spinae

Day 3. afternoon: Deep nuchal muscles, trigonum suboccipitale, m. erector spinae, mm. multifidi

Upper extremity:

Day 1. afternoon:

Scapular region, structures of the axillary fossa, humerotricipital and omotricipital foramen

Anterior brachial region, skin and subcutaneous tissue (skin innervation, superficial veins)

Day 2. morning:

Anterior brachial region, brachial fascia, muscles of the anterior group, medial bicipital groove - structures

Anterior antebrachial region, skin and subcutaneous tissue (skin innervation, superficial veins)

Day 2. afternoon:

Anterior antebrachial region, fascia, muscles, median and ulnar nerves and vessels of the forearm

Carpal canal, palmar region (superficial layer – palmar aponeurosis, innervation)

Day 3. morning :

Palmar region (muscles of the hand)

Dorsal brachial region, triceps brachii, the deep brachial vessels and nerves

Day 3. afternoon:

Dorsal antebrachial region, radial nerve

Dorsal side of the hand, osteofascial canals of the extensors

Lower extremity:

Day 1. afternoon:

Gluteal region, gluteus maximus, gluteus medius and minimus, supra- and infrapiriform foramina,

Day 2. morning:

Posterior femoral region and popliteal fossa, subcutaneous tissue and fascia, muscles, the sciatic nerve

Day 2. afternoon:

Posterior crural region, lesser saphenous vein, sural nerve, muscles, tibial nerve, posterior tibial vessels, medial malleolar region; plantar region-skin, plantar aponeurosis, the middle and deep layer of the muscles, nerves and vessels

Day 3. morning:

Anterior femoral region, skin innervation, greater saphenous vein, tractus iliotibialis, medial and anterior group of the muscles of thigh, the femoral triangle, the adductor canal

Day 3. afternoon:

Anterior crural region, the common fibular nerve+branches; dorsal side of the foot
