## Indications

Addison's disease

Arthritis (autoimmune and gouty) and osteoarthritis

Asthma bronchiale

Autoimmune diseases (MS, systemic lupus, dermatomyositis, vasculitis, hemolytic anemia, etc.)

Covid-19

Dermatological diseases (eczema, psoriasis, seborrheic dermatitis)

Brain edema

Eosinophilic esophagitis

Hemato-oncological diseases

Laryngitis in children

Otitis

Corrosion, burns, injuries, eye surgery

Prevention of transplant rejection

Premature delivery

Status asthmaticus

Severe allergies (including drug allergies) and anaphylaxis

Ulcerative colitis and Crohn's disease (anywhere in the intestine)

Ulcerative colitis of the rectum and sigmoid

Vomiting after chemo- or radiotherapy
