Topics worth to review (+ reference to lecture number L#)

 - angle of elevation and depression (L5)
 - distance from a starting point after an object/live being consecutively moves in two different directions (the prospector in forest case, a crawling ant, etc.) (L6)
 - Resolving force vector for an object on a ramp (L6)
