



REVISION OF MODAL VERBS

FORM AND USE

- Modals do not take a final **-s**, even when the subject is *she*, *he*, *it* (**She** *can do it*.). The only exception is *have to:* **She** *has to do it*.
- Modals have the same form in all persons.
- Modals are followed immediately by the simple form of a verb. (She can **do** it.)
- ➤ There is no do or does in questions or negative phrases. (She can do it. Can she do it? She cannot do it.) The only exception is have to: She doesn't have to do it. Does she have to do it?

need not		lack of necessity: He needn't come.
have to/has to		necessity/obligation: You can't turn right. You have to turn left.
don't have to/doesn't have to		= it's not necessary: We don't have to wear a uniform at my school.
mustn't		= it is necessary that you do not do it, you can't, it's prohibited/negative obligation: You must keep it a secret. You mustn't tell anyone.
should		something is/isn't a good idea/the right thing to do (to give advice, to make suggestion):
shouldn't		You look tired. You <i>should</i> go to bed. You <i>shouldn't</i> watch TV.
would		a hypothetical action or event in the present: I would go there if I had time. (But I don't have it.)
would not		
may, might		= it's possible: It may/might be true.
may not, might not		= perhaps it isn't true: I'm not sure whether I can
		lend you any money. I <i>may not</i> have enough.
