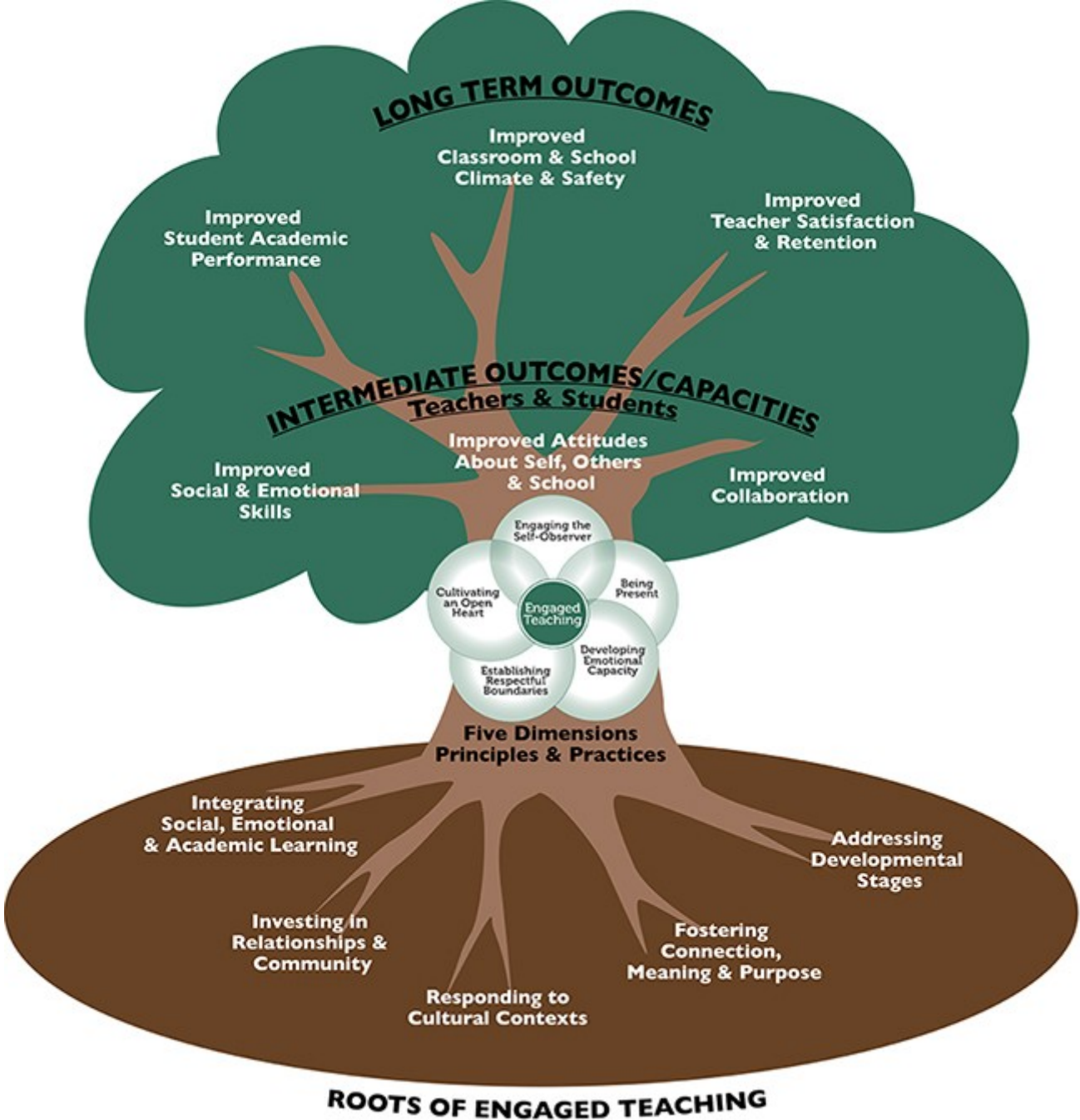


Engaged Teaching
