Anne's death from plague in 1394 at Sheen Manor was a **devastating blow** to Richard.

11 MAY 1366 – 7 JUNE 1394

Queen Consort of England, wife of Richard II.

She influenced the England fashion by introducing sidesaddle for riding or wearing the Bohemian double-horned headdress.
