

Prague astronomical clock (courtesy Ant. Vrba)







Prague astronomical clock: the whole






Calendarium: pictorial represenation (Oct.)

New design - astrolabium






Positions of the clock hands on the clock face



Johannes Gutenberg (c. 1400- 1468) the invention of the printing press




Gutenberg: statue in Mainz

- Roman origins of the town:
- Römersteine
- (Roman stones)
- Remnants of a Roman aqueduct, northmost from Rome

- Römisches Theater
- Roman theatre
- (10 thousand people)
- Discovered 1914-1916





Mainz (Mohuč) up to Gutenberg's lifetime


- Port on Rhine
- Opposite Wiesbaden
- Celtic settlement
- Romans: 14-9 BC,
- until 451 AD
- 1244 free imperial city
- "Golden Mainz", Center of Rhenish towns
- 14th century archbishops of M. chancellors and electors of Holy Roman E.
- 1440- book printing
- 1460s economic decline, citizens deprived of privileges



In Gutenberg's time, Mainz, Germany, was a busy riverside town, as seen in this fifteenth-century illustration.


Johannes Gutenberg

- 24 June 1400




Johannes de Altavilla (Eltville)







Upper Case and Lower Case


