
Prepositions of Time (in, on, at)

IN We use **in** with <u>years</u>, <u>seasons</u> and <u>months</u>. I got married in 2007. I got married in winter. I got married in December. On We use **on** with days and dates. I got married on 31st December. I got married on New Year's Eve AΤ We use at with times and well-known holiday periods. I got married at 3.30. I got married at New Year. Here are some other examples you should learn: **In** + the morning, the afternoon, the evening, but **at** night. At + mealtimes (at breakfast, at dinner ...). At + the weekend. At the moment, at present, at that moment. **In** the past, **in** the future. Remember: we don't use in/on/at when we say "this / last / next". I'll see you next week. 


