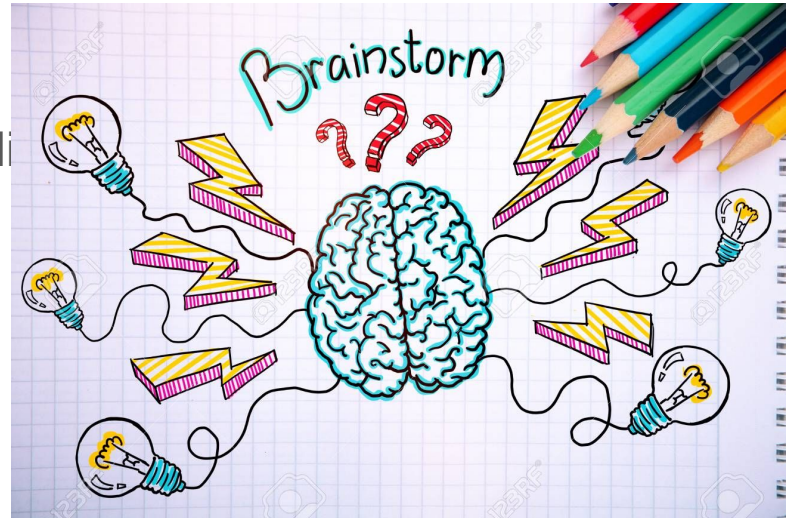
# What are (some of) the issues?
