Semantic roles of clause elements - KEY

SUBJECT - agentive participant (the doer of the action)

- the animate participant that causes the happening denoted by the verb
- John is cleaning the windows.

DIRECT OBJECT - affected participant

- animate or inanimate, not causing the happening but directly involved in the action
- We've sold our house.

INDIRECT OBJECT - recipient participant

- animate being, passively involved by the happening or state - *I bought him a book*.

SUBJECT or OBJECT COMPLEMENT - attribute

- current attribute: with verbs used statively

- resulting attribute: with verbs used dynamically

- *She is* **my sister**. *I consider her* **my best friend**.= current attribute

- *She became a teacher*. *She drives me mad*. = resulting attribute

- *She is a doctor*. *They named their son James*. = identification

- *She is a good doctor*. *I find her clever*. = characterization
