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DEFINITION OF DYSGRAPHIA IN CZECH REPUBLIC



- "Dysgraphia is a writing disorder which affects the graphic side of the written speech. These include readability and editing of written text."
- Dysgraphia is not related to movement disorder or sensory impairment
- From the beginning, the disorder can be considered laziness



- "Dysgraphia is characterized as a learning disability in the category of written expression when one's writing skills are below those expected given a person's age measured through intelligence and age appropriate education."
- Absence of handwriting and spelling skills
- Often the stress and frustration of writing



- "Dysgraphia is a disorder of writing ability at any stage, including problems with letter formation/legibility, letter spacing, spelling, fine motor coordination, rate of writing, grammar, and composition."
- Impairment in the production of written text
- Dysgraphia can be acquired

WHAT ARE THE MAIN FEATURES OF DYSGRAPHIA?

• dysgraphia is described as a specific disability of graphic expression

Deficits:

- fine and gross motor skills
- movement coordination
- movement memory, visual memory
- spatial orientation



SPECIFIC SIGNS OF DYSGRAPHIA

There are some skills that people with dysgraphia may struggle with:

- memory
- font
- spelling
- writing clearly
- similar letters
- geometry
- drawing



DOES DYSGRAPHIA OCCUR ALONE?

- dyslexia
- OWL LD (oral and written language learning disability)
- ADHD (attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder)
- mental disorders



- Diagnosed by a **special educator** in educational and psychological counselling centre.
- The **psychologist** can help with diagnosis
- The specialist will **look** at their:
 - gross and fine motor skills
 - Finished work
 - Hand and body position
 - Pencil grip
 - **Posture**
 - Writing process
 - Drawing process



DIAGNOSIS OF DYSGRAPHIA



- Diagnosed by a **licensed psychologist** trained in learning disorders.
- Pediatrician rule out other diseases.
- Occupational therapist works with child's motor skills.





TREATMENT OF DYSGRAPHIA

• There's no cure for dysgraphia.

- Medication used to **treat ADHD** has helped with dysgraphia in some kids who have **both conditions**.
- Problems associated with writing and fine motor skills can be improved.

GROSS MOTOR SKILLS

Gross motor skills include:

- sitting
- crawling
- running
- jumping
- throwing a ball
- climbing stairs



IN DYSGRAPHIA THERAPY WE CAN FOCUS ON


FINE MOTOR SKILLS

The use of the smaller muscle of the hands


- using pencils,

- doing up buttons and opening lunch boxes.




HOW TO HOLD A PENCIL CORRECTLY



- 1. Put your thumb and forefinger about 3 cm above the coned end of the pencil.
- 2. Let the pencil rest between your thumb and forefinger.
- 3. Then put your middle finger underneath for support.




