Decide about the following modals (whether they express ability, permission or possibility), and label each sentence accordingly: A = ability / I = inability, Per = permission, Poss = possibility:

She <u>can</u> speak English very well. It <u>may / might / could</u> rain tomorrow.

<u>Can</u> I join you? When I was young I <u>could</u> speak English better than my sister.

I <u>could</u> go there if I wanted. It <u>may/might/could</u> be raining. She <u>cannot</u> sing very well.

Even at the age of 15 she <u>could not</u> swim at all. <u>Might I perhaps look at it?</u>

<u>Could</u> I go to the theatre tonight? <u>May</u> I open the window?

It <u>may / might / could</u> have rained.
