
Chips and juice /tʃ/ and /dʒ/

How to make the sound /ts/



• Look at the diagram. Listen and say the sound. There is no voicing (vibration from the throat). $/t \int \int dt \, dt \, dt$ together. Target sound: /t so/

• /t \int / is usually spelled ch, t, or tch. Listen and say these words.



How to make the sound /d3/



• Look at the diagram. Listen and say the sound. There is voicing (vibration from the throat). $\frac{d3}{d3}$ is like $\frac{d}{d4} + \frac{3}{3}$ together. Target sound: /d3ə/

• /dʒ/ is usually spelled j, g, ge or dge. Listen and say these words.

Note: The name of the letter G is /dʒiː/, and the name of the letter J is /dʒeː/. Listen and repeat.




