How to complete the portfolio task

- a) **Choose ONE** of the tasks below for your diagnostic process. For each task, you will find a template in the learning materials file (PdF:SZ6646 Educational and Psychological Assessment in Teaching Practice (muni.cz). You can choose from the following topics:
- Diagnosing learning outcomes and the process of learning
- Diagnosing social relationships in the classroom
- Case studies of problem behaviour of pupils
- Using assessment to support learning
- b) Follow the steps in a the teplate of a chosen topic.
- c) After fulfilling the portfolio task, evaluate your work in a provided chart of the teplate.
- d) Send your portfolio task document by e-mail to a selected classmate for peer evaluation.
- e) The classmate will read your document, evaluate it, write a recommendation for possible modifications and send it back to you by e-mail. In return, you will also **provide feedback** to a selected classmate.
- f) **Edit** your portfolio task according the recommendations if you find them constructive. If you disagree with the recommendations, defend your standpoind, explain the reasons for your decisions.
- g) **Submit** your portfolio in the homework vaults (please submit the complete document which already involves egg to egg check-up, your self-assessment, peer-assessment and your comments on the feedback as well as your experience with the diagnostic process).
