- **We need to start to think how to really exploit that rather than just use it.**







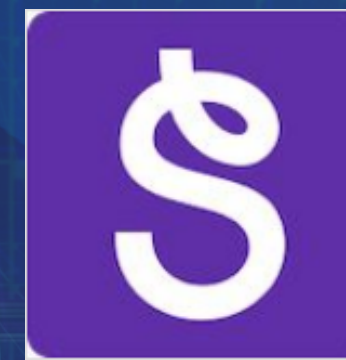
# Strategies

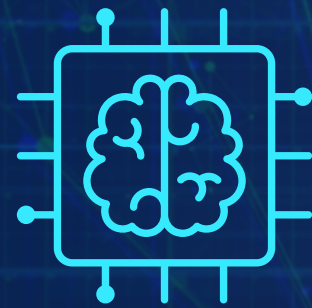

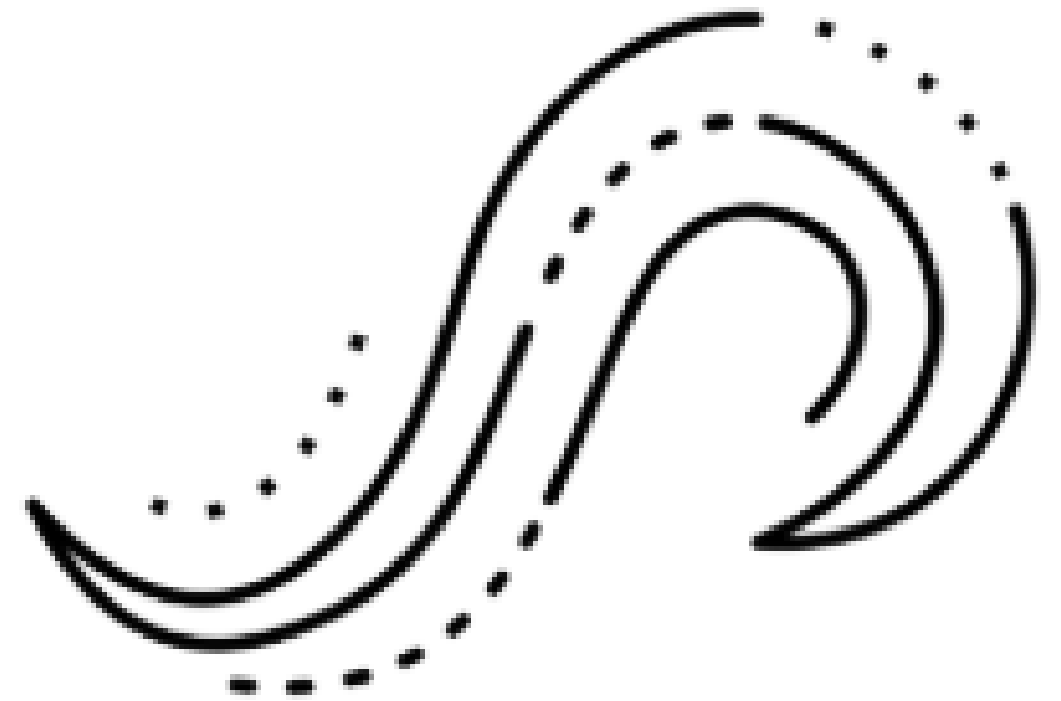

Let me explain



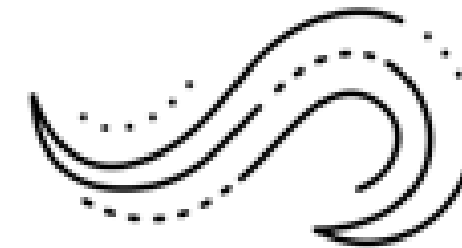
### Part two. Victor's Story
