The little lobe of thymus gland, lob – ulus = smallness; little hearing bones, ossic – ulum = smallness, little tear channel – ulus = smallness; bilateral bronchitis – itis= inflammation, necrosis after a difficult operation – necr – osis = non inflammatory disease, necros= dead, opera – tio = activity; incurable cancer – in= no, negation, sana-bilis = possibility; purulent infection – pur – u – lenta = full of; purulent inflammation of muscles – myos – itis = inflammation; inflammation of colon (large intestine) with ulcers – col – itis = inflammation; ulcer – osa = full of; fatty cyst under the skin – lip-oma= tumor (like a tumor), sub- under; chronic arthrosis – arthr – osis= non inflammatory disease; small body – corpusc – ulum= smallnes

Opium in the form of powder – pulver – atus = form; solutions based on water, spirit (distilled alcohol), oil – solu – tio= activity result, -osa = full of; ointments for external use – lini-mentum= activity result; a bottle with a lid – opercul – atum = equipped with; waxed paper – cer- ata = equipped with
