

## Latin paradigm, Greek paradigm

### 1st declension

#### SG

Gutta (Latin feminines) diabetes (Greek masculines) systole (Greek feminines)

1. gutt-a	diabet-es	systole-e
2. gutt-ae	diabet-ae	systole-es
4. gutt-am	diabet-am, (or Greek suffix -en)	systole-en
6. gutt-a	diabet-a (or Greek suffix -e)	systole-e

PL = gutta

### 2nd declension

#### SG

Sirupus (Latin masculines) (Greek neuters)	nephros (Greek masc.)	unguentum (Latin neuters)	colon
1. sirupus	nephros	unguentum	col-on
2. sirup-i	nephri	unguenti	col-i
4. sirup-um	nephron	ungentum	col-on
6. sirup-o	nephro	ungent-o	col-o

PL= sirupus + unguentum

### 3rd declension

#### SG

Auris (Latin msc + fem)	dosis (Greek fem)
1. aur-is	dosis
2. aur-is	dos-is(-eos)
4. aur-em	dos-im(-in)
6. aur-e	dos-i

PL = auris
