Premoral tooth , prae -before, preceding; fascia of the forearm , ante-before; vessels bringing the blood into and out of the heart, af=ad, ef=ex; dilation of the heart, di=dis, apart from; chronic peritonitis, peri=around; cancer with metastases, meta=after, secondary; suprarenal gland, supra=over; interosseous artery, inter=between; the head of adductor muscle, ad=toward; artery bent around, circum=around; disease returning back, re=again; partial fracture of a bone, in=into; subacute, acute and very acute disease, inoperable tumour, bleeddeing to death after rupture of the femoral vein, medication before a surgery, drugs causing shrinking, drugs releasing mucus, injection under the skin, into the muscle, into the vein, analgesic against pain, contraceptives, prescription of a medicament according to the law of art, diluted acid, substance that gives the medicament its form, blood analysis, contraindication of a remedy, venoms and drugs that must be separated (kept apart), oral application.
