### NOUNS:

Quality, state :	-antia, -entia -ies, -ities -itas -or
Instrument, organ:	-bra, -brum
Specific names:	-ina, -inum -ium (chemical terms)
Activity, its result:	<b>-tio, -sio, -xio</b> <b>-tor, -sor, -xor</b> <b>-tura, -sura</b> <b>-tus, -sus, -xus</b> <b>-men, -mentum</b>
Deminutives:	vowel + -(l)lus, -(l)la, -(l)lum <b>-ellus, a, um</b> <b>-illus, a, um</b> <b>-ulus, a, um</b> <b>-olus, a, um</b>

### ADJETIVES: relation +:

Tendency:	-ax, -ix, -ox
Equipped with:	-tus, <b>-atus</b>
Possibility:	<b>-bilis</b>
Full of:	<b>-lentus</b> <b>-osus</b>

### GREEK SUFFIXES: pathological conditions:

Disease:	-ia, -iasis
Condition, ill state:	-ismus
Inflammation:	<b>-itis</b>
Tumor:	<b>-oma</b>
Non-inflammatory d.:	<b>-osis</b>
