TITLE	ATTRIBUTED TO	CONTENT
<i>Cypria</i>	Stasinus of Cyprus	The events leading up to the Trojan War and the first nine years of the conflict, especially the Judgement of Paris
<i>Iliad</i>	Homer	Achilles' rage against first king Agamemnon and then the Trojan prince Hector, ending with Achilles killing Hector in revenge for the death of Patroclus
<i>Aethiopis</i>	Arctinus of Miletus	The arrival of the Trojan allies, Penthesileia the Amazon and Memnon; their deaths at Achilles' hands in revenge for the death of Antilochus; Achilles' own death
<i>Little Iliad</i>	Lesches of Mytilene	The events after Achilles' death, including the building of the Trojan Horse
<i>Ilioupersis</i>	Arctinus of Miletus	The destruction of Troy by the Greeks
<i>Nostoi</i>	Agius of Troezen or Eumelus of Corinth	The return home of the Greek force and the events contingent upon their arrival, concluding with the returns of Agamemnon and Menelaus
<i>Odyssey</i>	Homer	The end of Odysseus' voyage home and his vengeance on his wife Penelope's suitors, who have devoured his property in his absence
<i>Telegony</i>	Eugammon of Cyrene	Odysseus' voyage to Thesprotia and return to Ithaca, and death at the hands of an illegitimate son Telegonus
