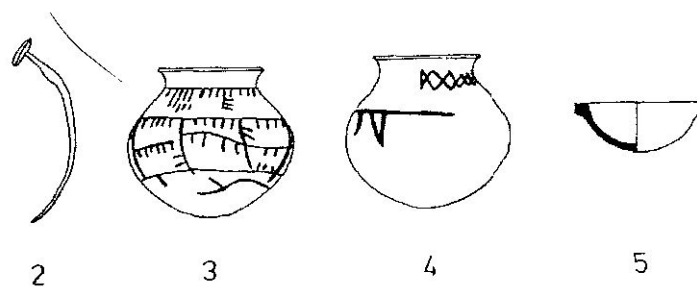

- Fig. 7: After Mallowan 1936: figs. 8: 8, 19: 8, 19: 6, 20: 14 (stone).

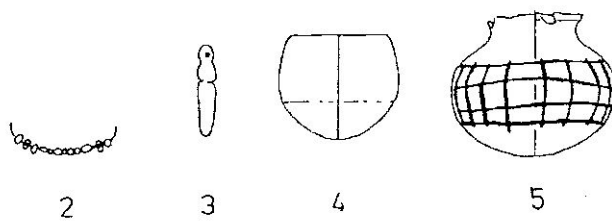

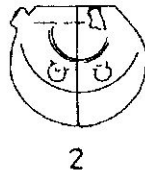
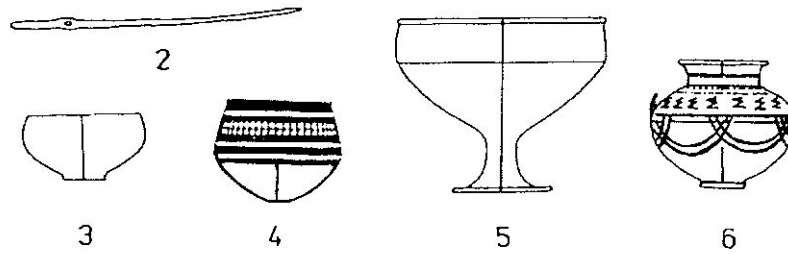


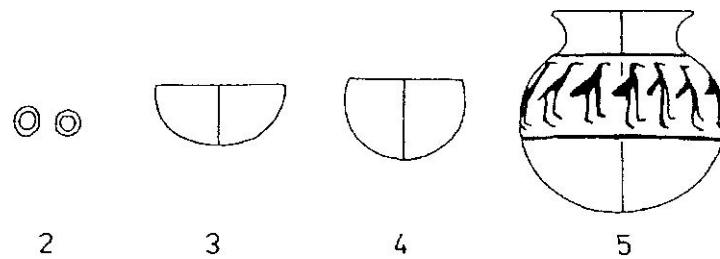
Fig. 10: After Mallowan 1937: fig. 19: 11.

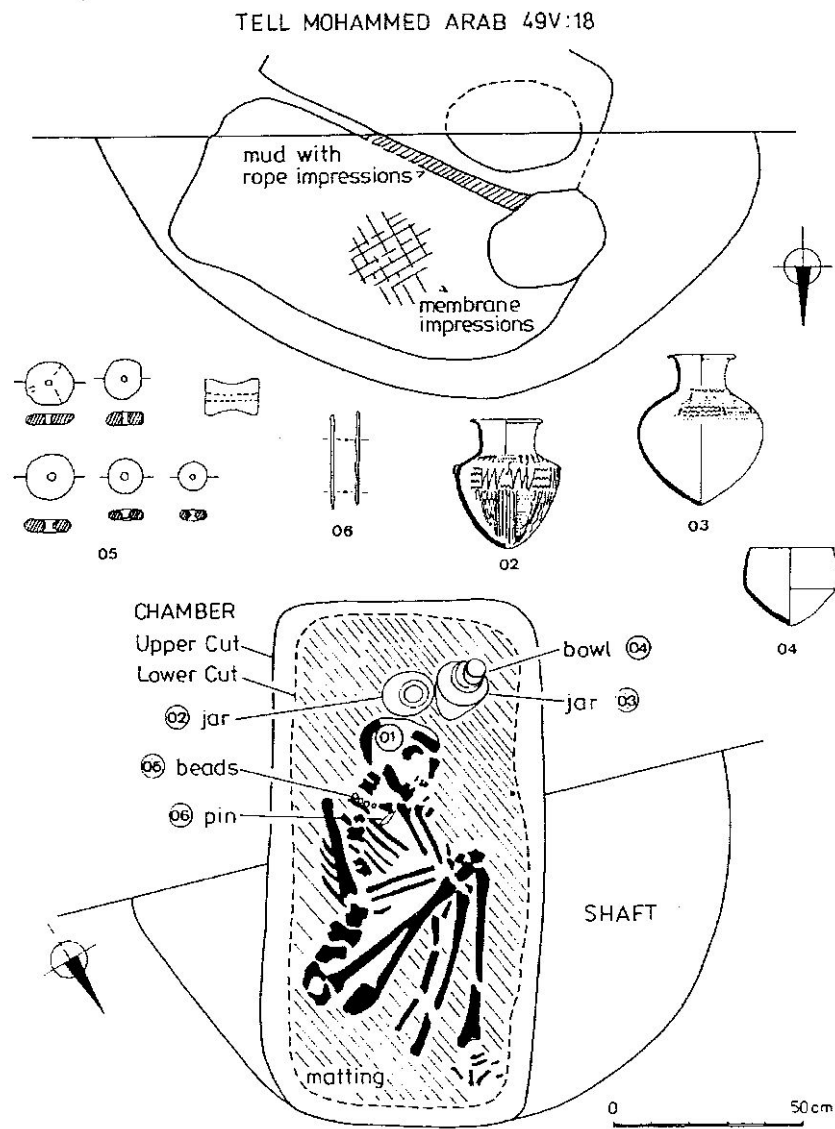


- Fig. 11: After Mallowan 1937: figs. 12: 1, 18: 7, 25: 1, 25: 2, 25: 3.

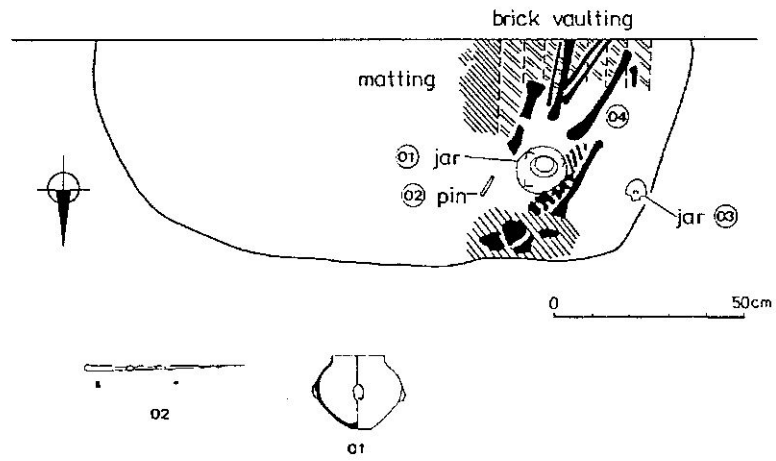


- Fig. 12: No. 2 is schematic. Others after Mallowan 1937: figs. 20: 7, 18: 13, 25: 9.

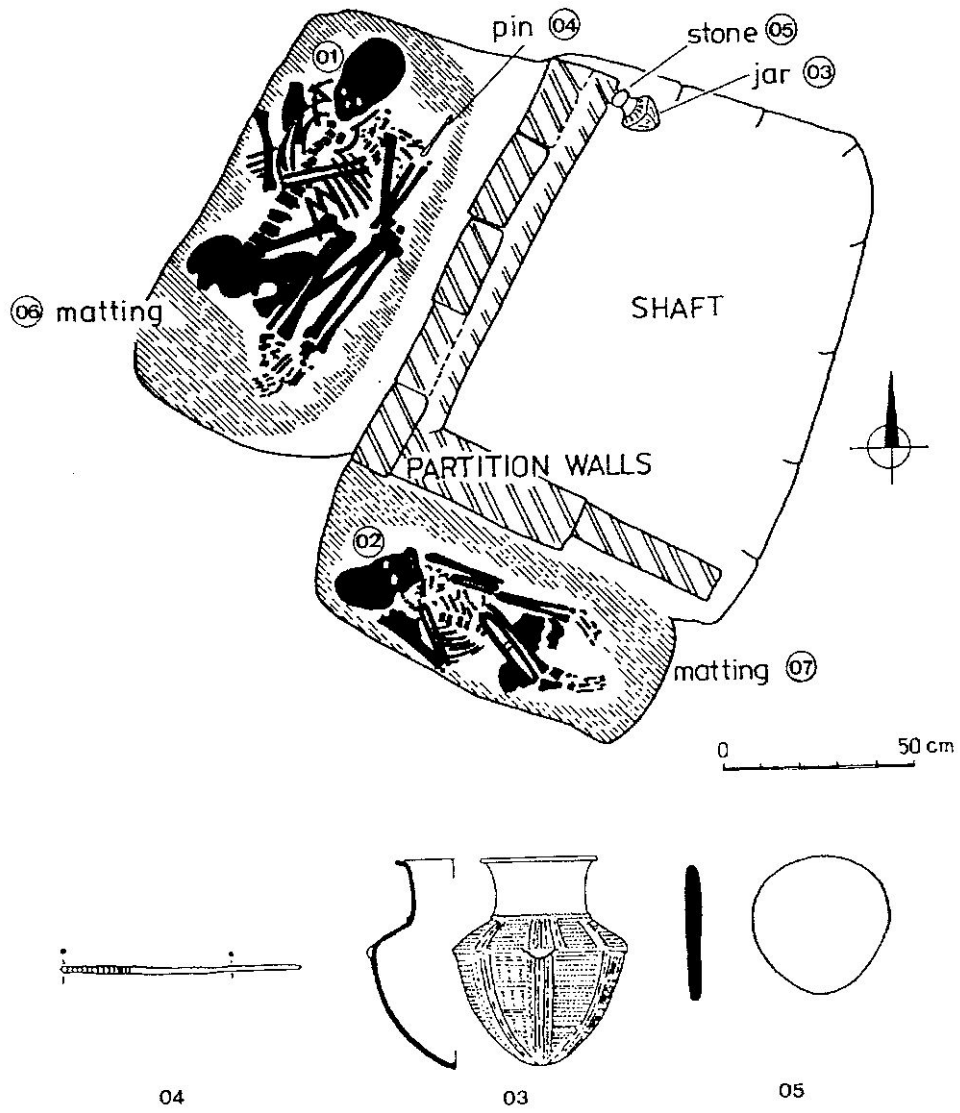


- Fig. 13: Unpublished. Cf. Roaf 1983a: 74; Roaf 1983b: 88-89 (MA 82. 94-96), 92 pl. 2: 94; Killick 198

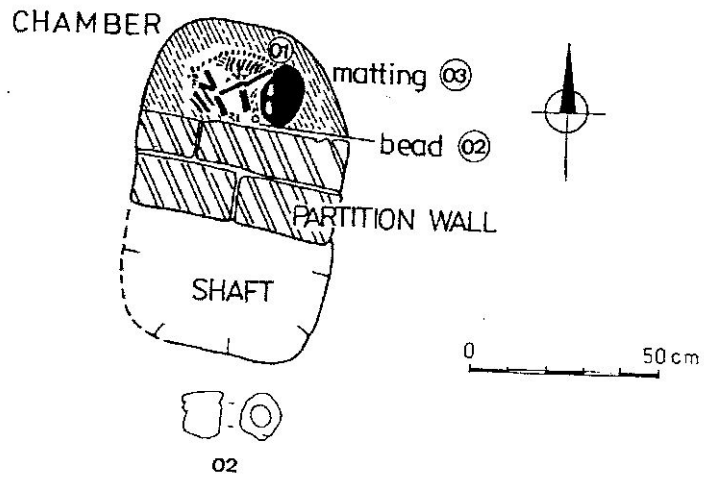


- Fig. 14: Unpublished. Cf. Roaf 1983a: 74; Roaf 1983b: 88-90 (MA 76, 97-98); Killick 1987: 216-217.



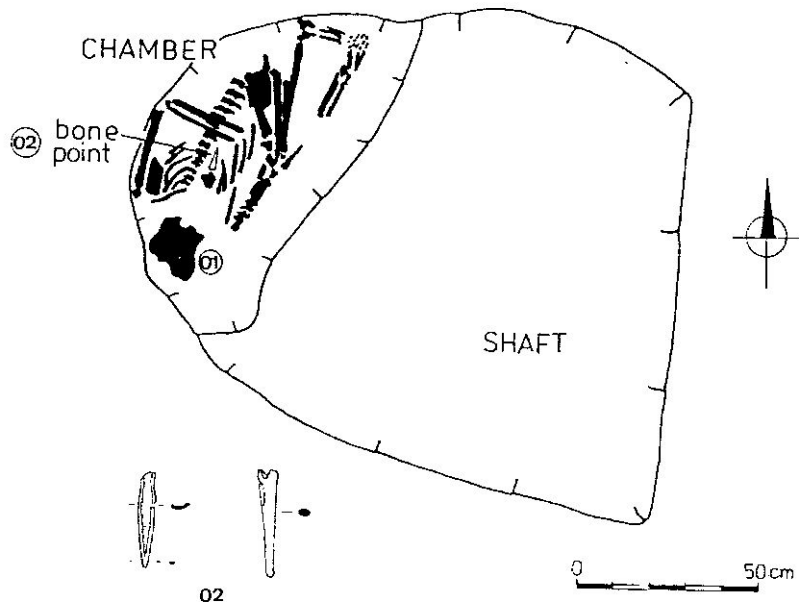
- Fig. 15: To be published in Killick, in prep.

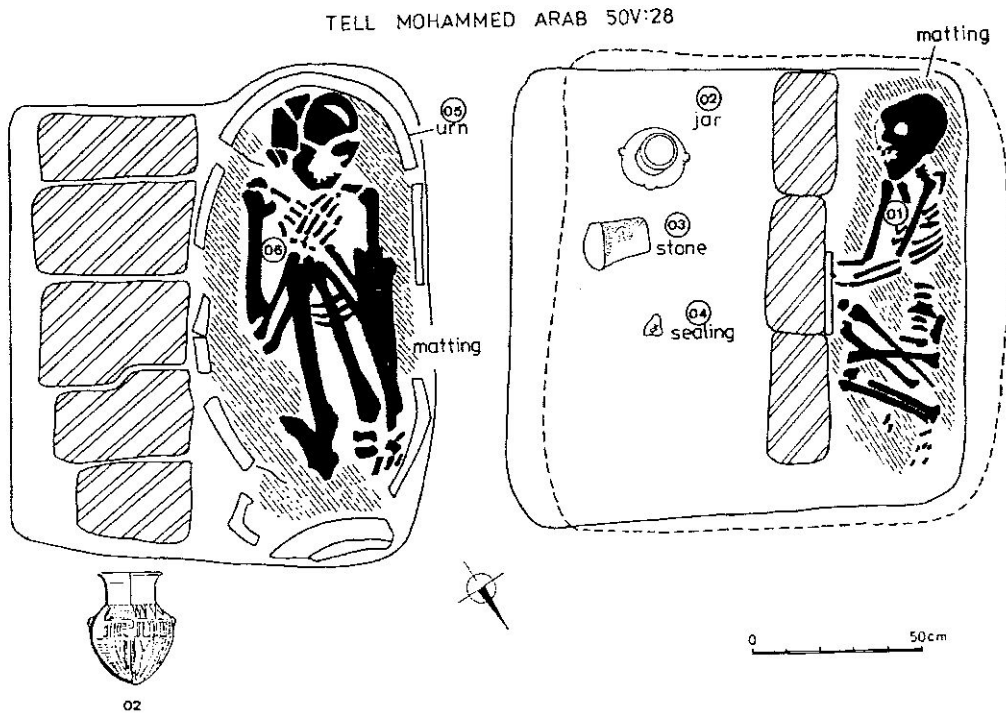


- Fig. 16: To be published in Killick, in prep.

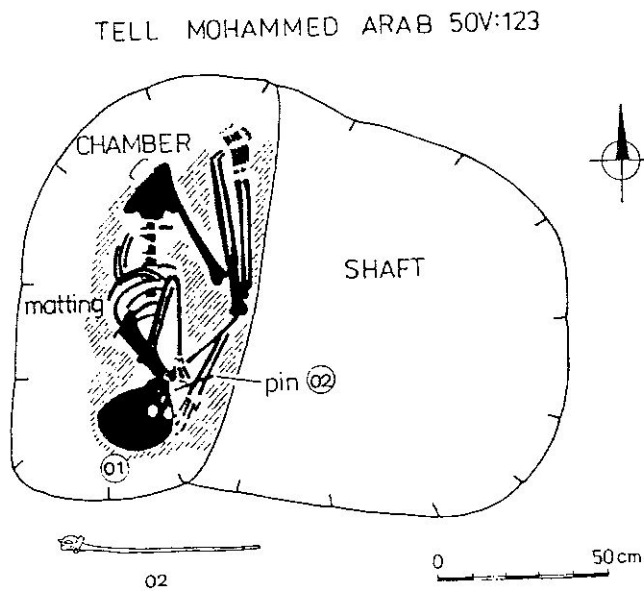

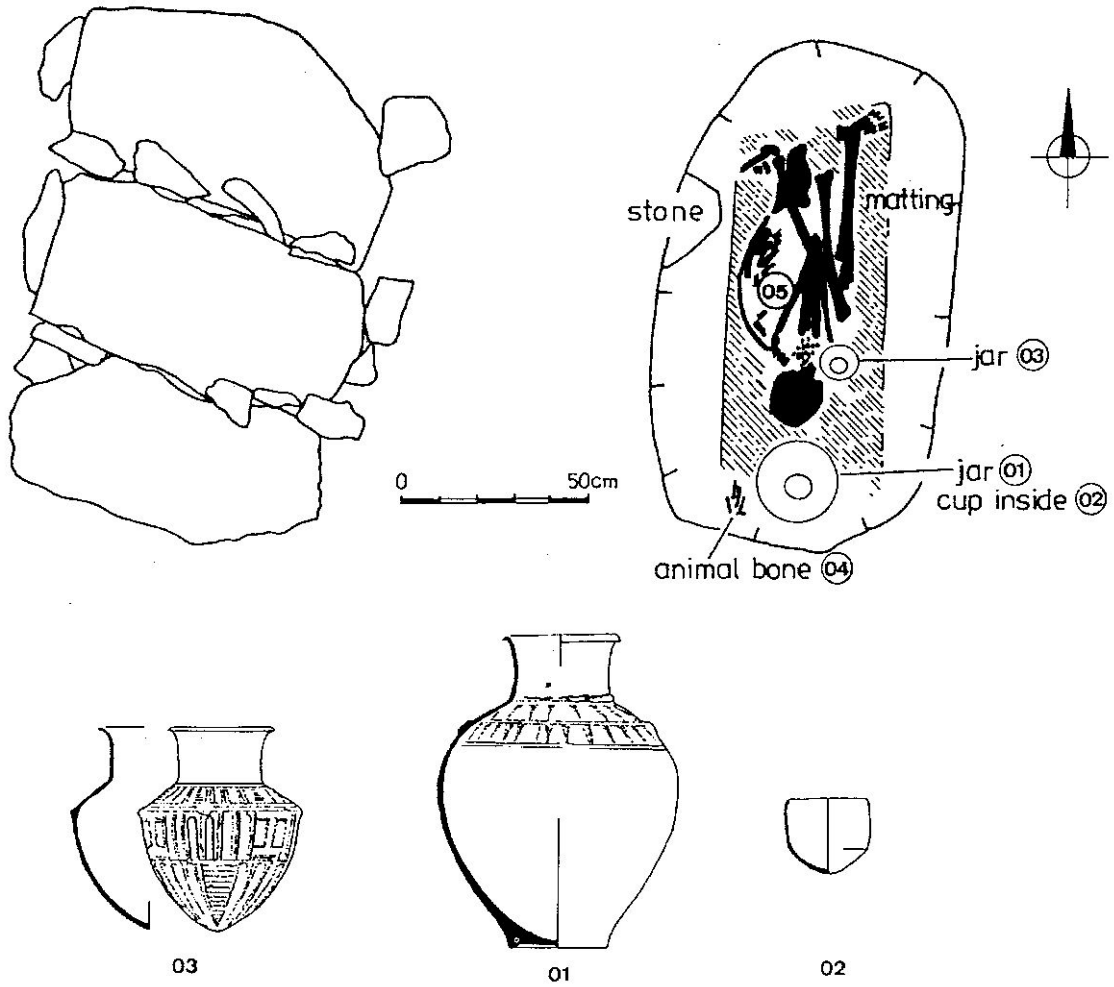


- Fig. 18: Unpublished. Cf. Roaf 1983a: 74; Roaf 1983b: 86-87 (MA 49, 67 [= 5)V:02.04, not "50V:02.03"], 68 [second sealing, not on our plan]; Killick 1987: 216-217 [adult burial only].



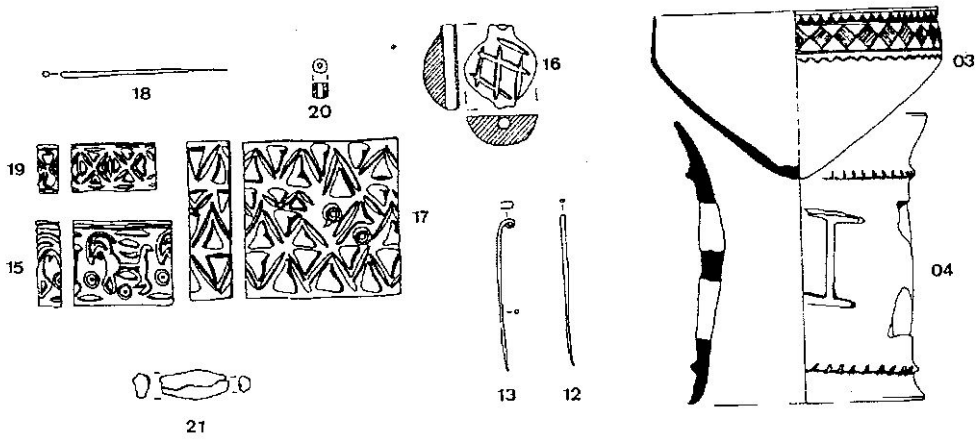
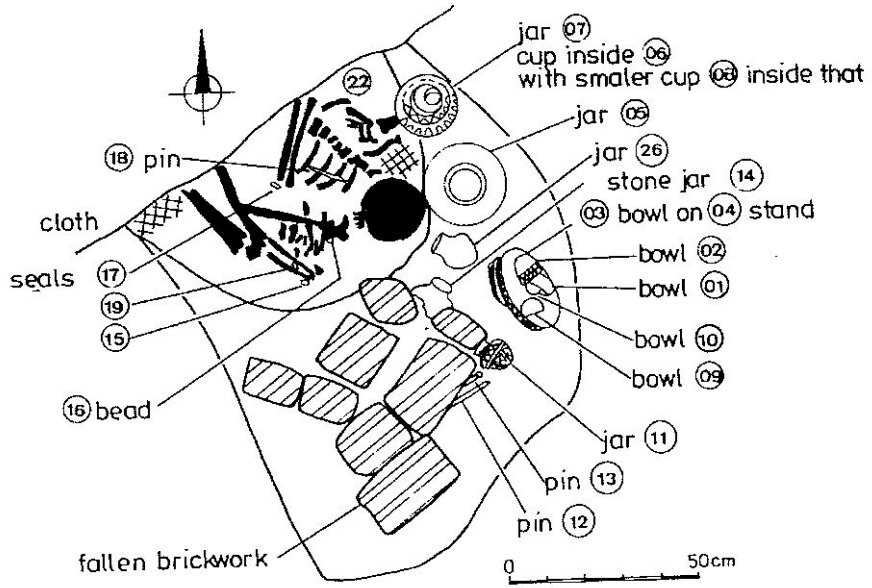
- Fig. 19: To be published in Killick, in prep. For the copper/bronze pin (50V:123.02), see Roaf 1984: pl. XIII: f (opp. p. 149), p. 153 [misnumbered "50U:168.04"].

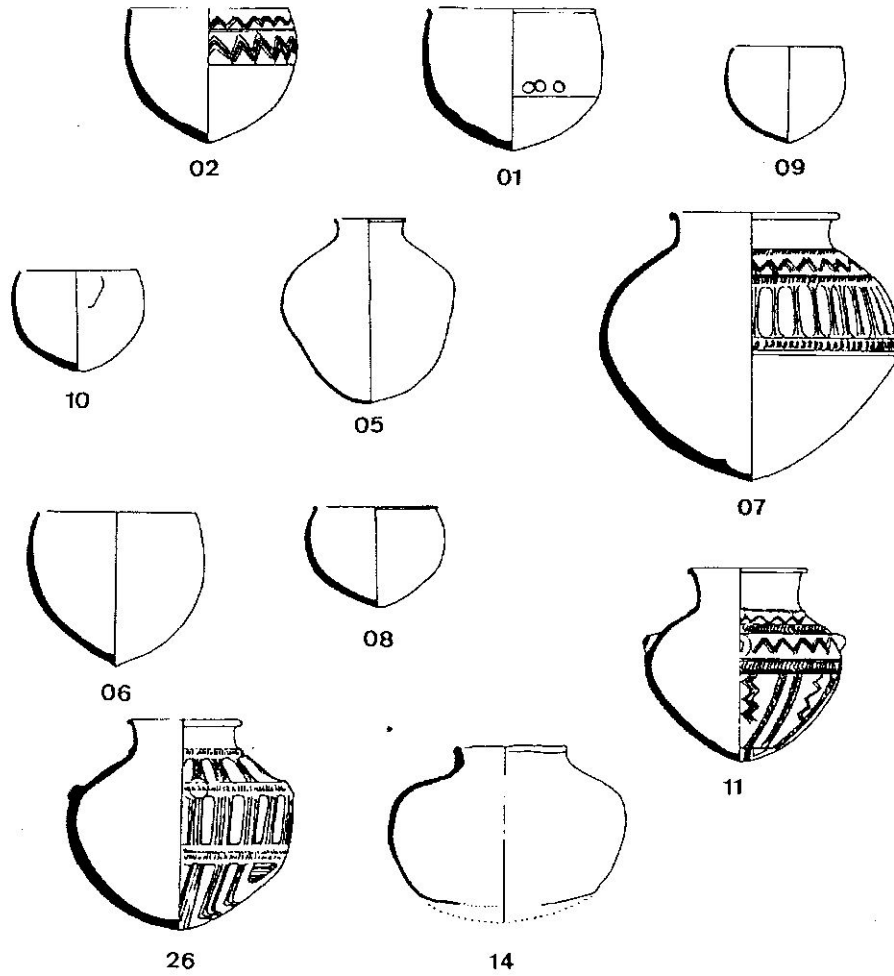


- Fig. 20: To be published in Killick, in prep.

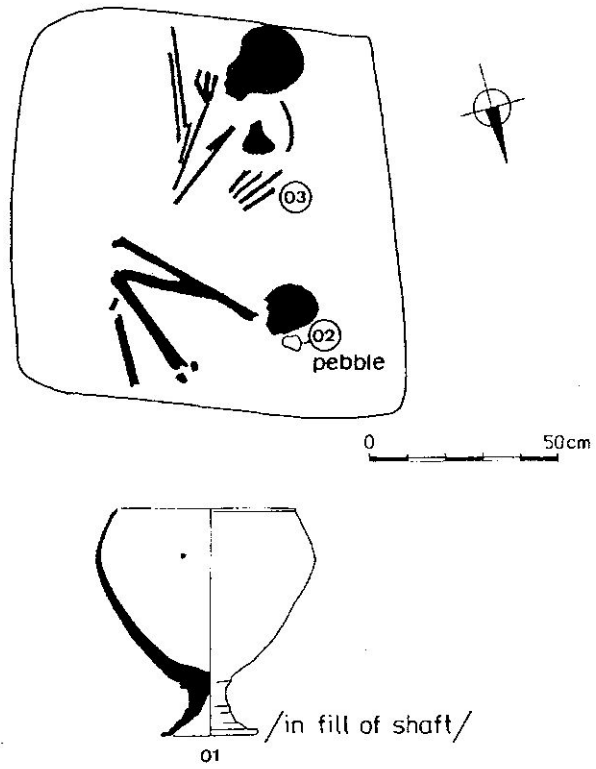


- Fig. 21: continued on facing page



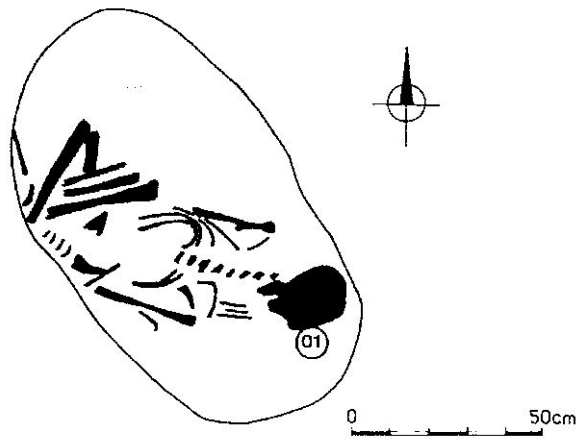
- Fig. 21: Plan and some grave goods unpublished. Cf. for now Roaf 1983a: 74, with p. 73 fig. 4 and p. 71 captions to fig. 4; Roaf 1983b: 83-88 (MA 4, 12-13, 20-22, 25, 30-32, 35-42, 47, 75).

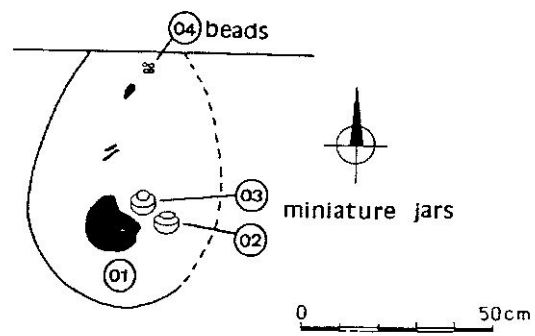
- Fig. 22: Unpublished. Cf. Killick 1987: 218.

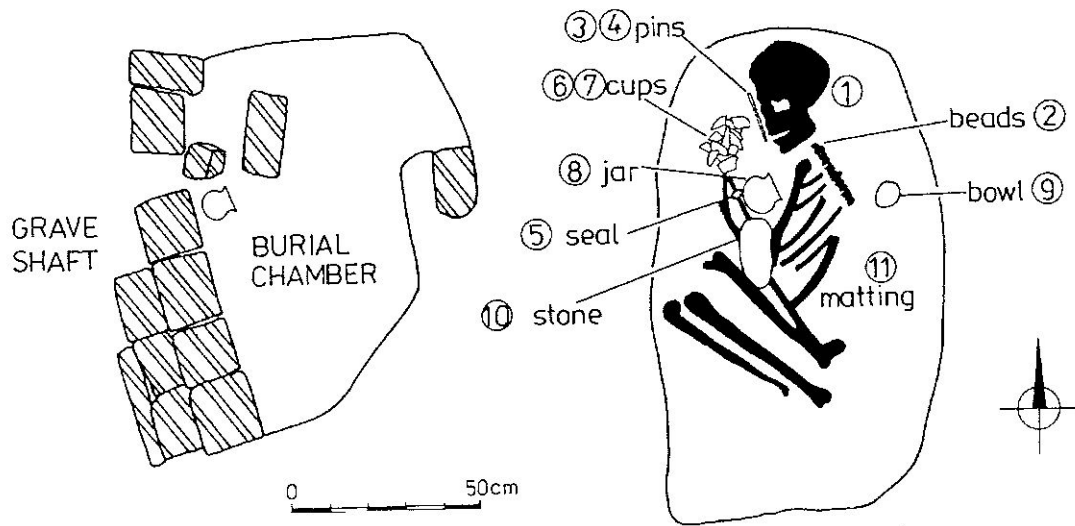
- Fig. 23: Unpublished.

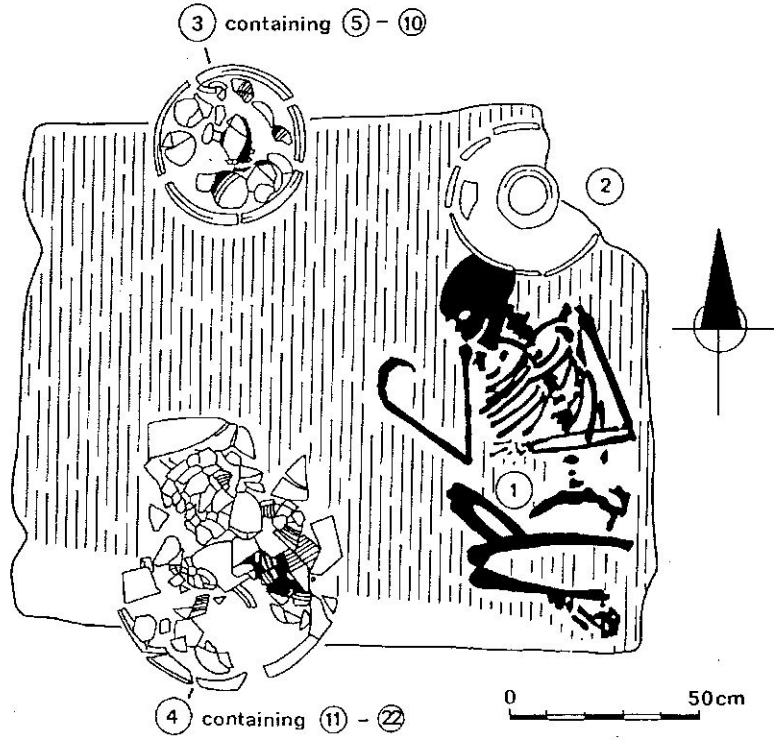
- Fig. 24: Unpublished.

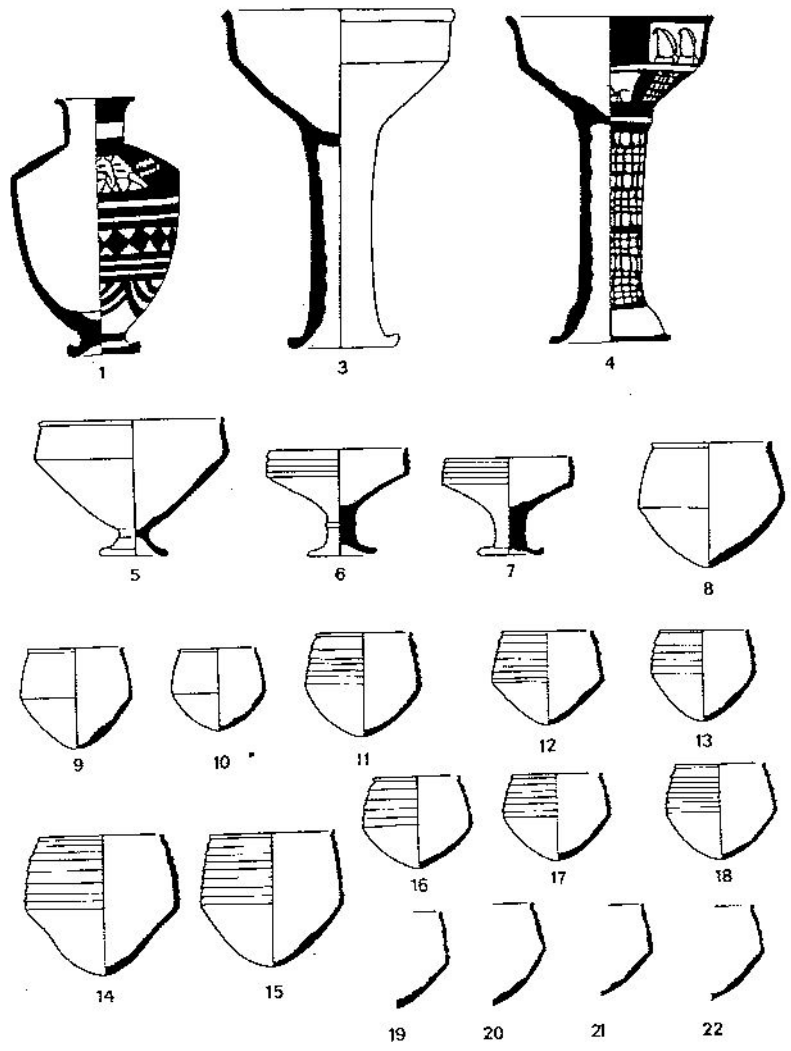


- Fig. 25: After Schwartz 1982: 67, fig. 24; and 68, fig. 25.

TELL RIJIM ADULT BURIAL

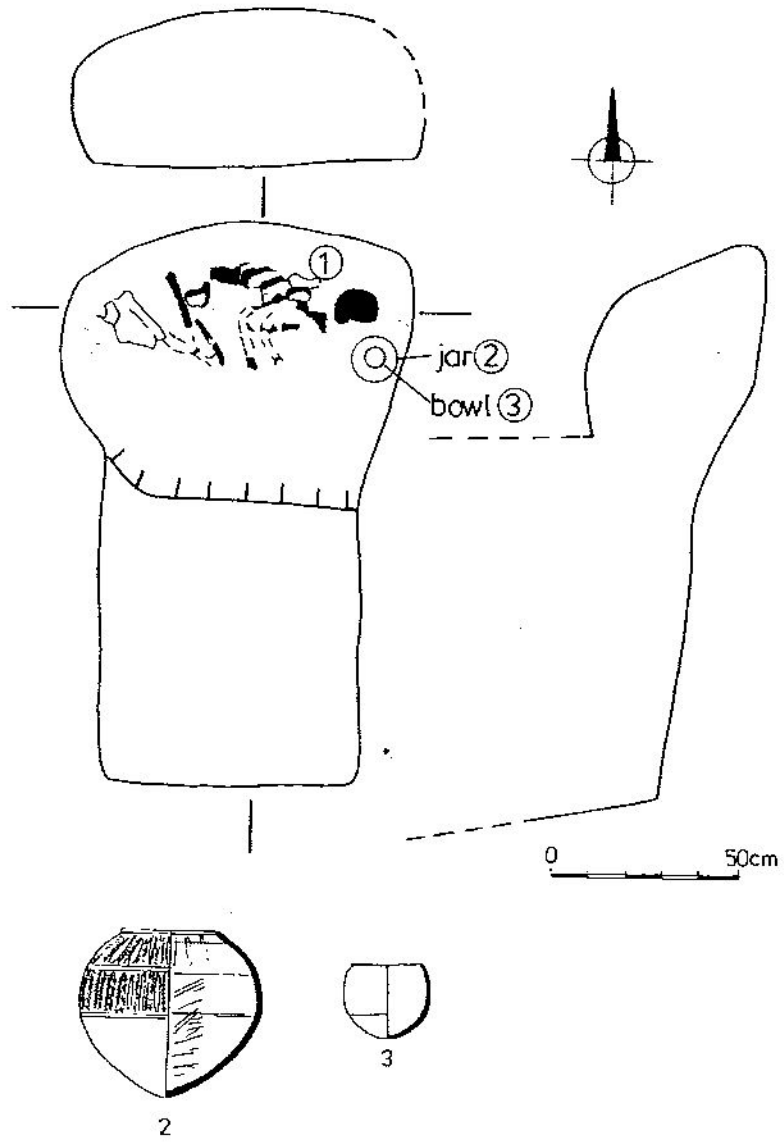


- Fig. 29: continued overleaf



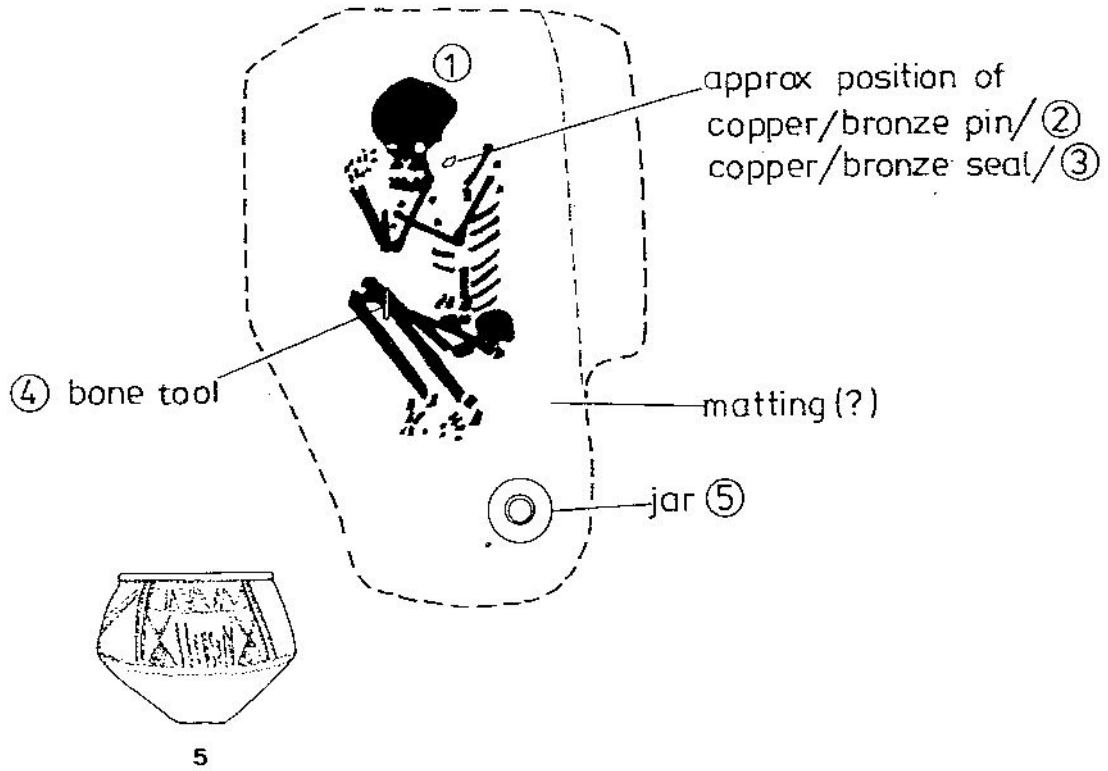
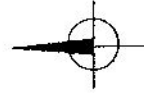
- Fig. 29: After Bielinski, this volume.
