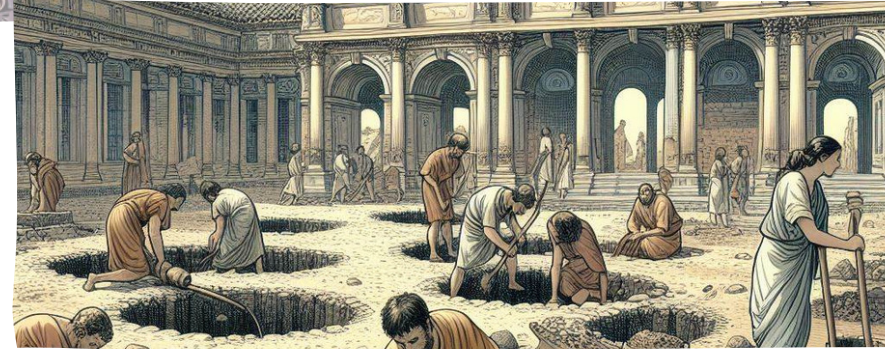
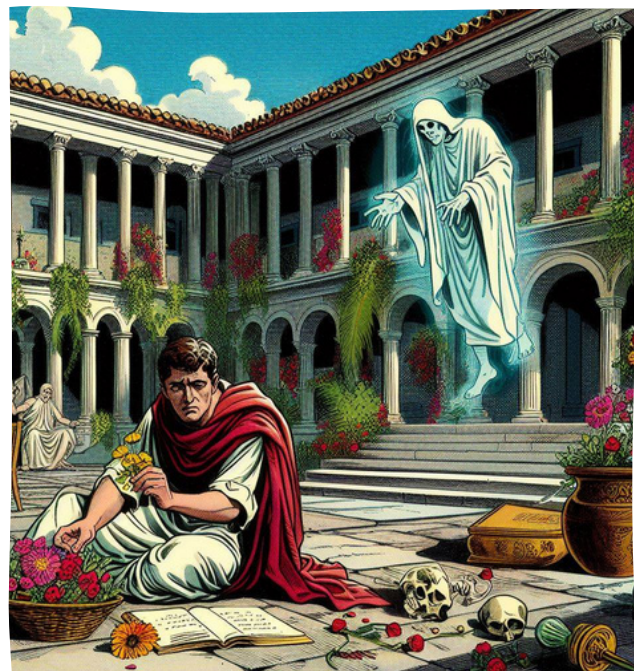
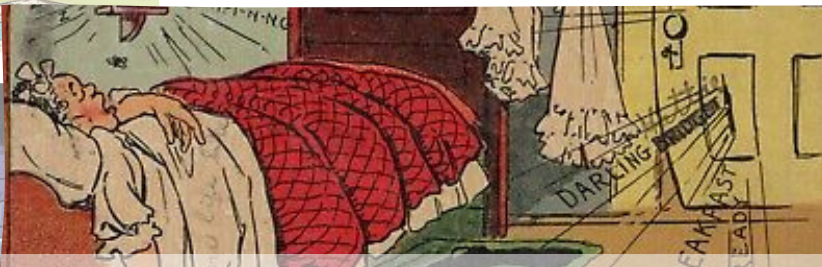
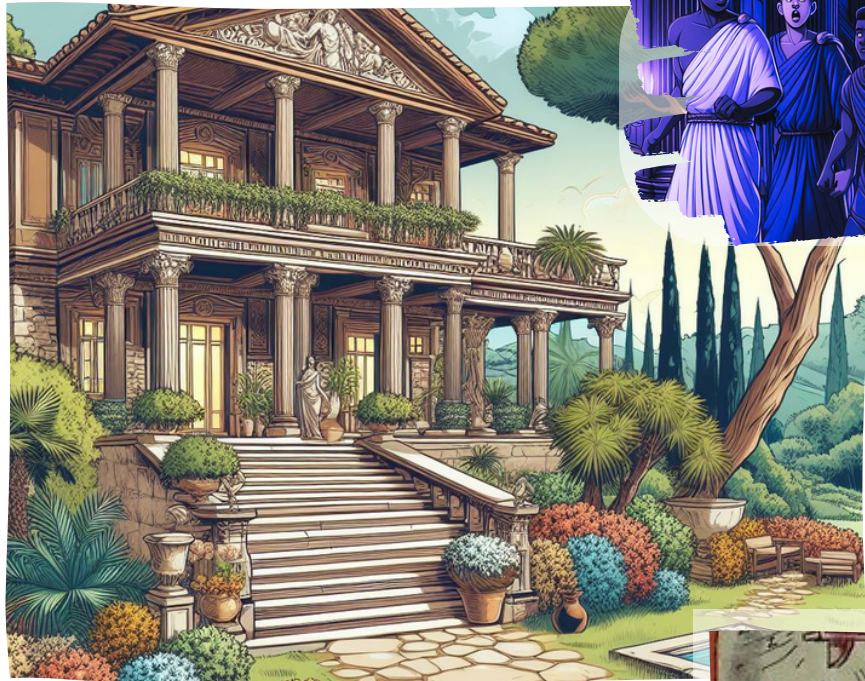


Athēnodōrus et īdolum
