In the field of Russian language and business many single stories can be seen. Here are three examples: First, the Nestor's manuscript is important source of Russian history, but there is no relevant proof who real author is the. Second, in Russian literature there is period called "The Golden Age of Russian literature", but there is no scientific evidence proving which period it is exactly. The third example refers to policy. The policy in Russia is complicated and the Russians have different opinions from the rest of the world. The situation in society and policy in Russia is difficult and it is hard to find good solutions.

Good points: clarity

Point to improve: variety of verbs (too many "to be"); sentence structure (subject-verb)

In the branch of philosophy every idea can be a single story. Philosophers bring new problems and questions into their field, they react to others philosophers. Each of them can have a different view of this world. For example, some philosophers think, that our world is a cylinder or a disk (reference). There is a difference between philosophy and science. According to science, our world is not like that (not like what?). But in the past these ideas were main points in thinking. Philosophy can give us a brand new view, but sometimes this view can be too terrifying for us. And also these views can be a single story.

Good points: grammatical accuracy Point to improve: clarity; variety of verbs (too many "to be")

Studying psychology is not about reading someone's mind, about judging someone, as many people think. People should think deeper or wider about so much interesting field. Psychology is not just about Freud and sex, there is so many interesting scientists and their researchers. Also general public should know that psychologists cannot read their thoughts also that psychologists are not judges.

Good points: grammatical accuracy; clarity Points to improve: register (choice of words and phrases), level of formality

In the field of European Studies, the society is not aware of what the job opportunities and possibilities for this field are. In this context, however, we also encounter that people do not understand the content of those studies, which is related to the inability to identify the job possibilities. The name of the filed, European Studies, brings considerable amount of bias, because study of the European Union is not considered as a single focus.

Good points: level of formality and style Points to improve: sentence structure

Studying a political science along with security and strategy is a concept that is hard to grasp for many people. The former is generally associated with being a guard in a shop. Latter is connected to active participation in politics, with a personal gain aim. According to Veronika, explaining the exact field of study in those two subjects is exhausting because organized crime, which is her main research subject, creates a cognitive shortcut to mafia, which is incorrectly perceived to be the same thing. Researching the organized crime substitutes for a police work for many people. Field researchers are also bound to find heads of horses, just like in the Godfather movie. While Veronika has positive attitude towards working in special services, she assumes that Faculty of Social Studies will not open a sufficient major for a long time.

Good points: level of formality and style

Points to improve: relative clauses, accuracy of expressions

Czech Republic has had a democratic political system since the Velvet Revolution in 1989. It is characterised by an equally participation on the government of all eligible citizens. The Czech Constitution declares an equal right to vote, a respect for human rights etc. According to last studies (reference) Czech people perceive democracy principles as a certain part of their lives. But they have not accepted yet that these principles have to be supported by democratic behaviour of the whole society, eg. participation in elections, follow the law.

Good points: level of formality and style, Points to improve: tenses, accuracy of words

Brno is a historical city with great cultural opportunities. This is a fact which we can read on the official website of Brno in this form: "More than 20 festivals of culture and theatre take place in the city each year". (reference) Brno, or more precisely, the Tugendhat Vila is also a member of The Unesco World Heritage Centre, as we can see on the World Heritage List. Dominant historical features of the city are the fortress of Špilberk castle and the Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul. Now we can say, that city is historical too. Brno inhabitants spend their leisure time in different ways than we suppose. Most of us prefer watching TV or shopping to attending cultural or sports events. The proof is sociological research called: "Leisure in the Czech Republic in a Brief Comparison with European Countries" . The survey was published by Jiří Šafr, Věra Patočková in 2010. The most favourite ways to spend leisure time according to this research are watching TV, listening to music and browsing on the internet. On the other hand, attending sports and cultural events (like theatre or museum) and going to the cinema are the least popular ways. This is a bad news for everyone, who is interested in culture.

Good points: clarity

Points to improve: choice of words, grammar (prepositions, articles)

Nowadays, there are a lot of students who decide to study social science. Even students in Brno can study at Faculty of Social Studies, which is one of the most respected institutions not only in Czech Republic, ...but also where?. One of the fields of study at the faculty is Political Science, which was founded in 1990.

Students who study this field encounter many questions from their surroundings. One of common(frequent?) questions is about their future job. Another one is if they want to be politicians. In these cases students have to explain what political science is and what areas they can focus on - transformation of non- democratic regimes, political marketing, project management in non-governmental organizations, etc.(see the Comment6)

After the explanation, some people might understand the aim of the field, but some of them will still consider it useless.

However, each field has its supporters and opponents, but in my opinion it is important to have well educated people in the society.

My field of study is a combination of psychology and sociology. The reaction of the public is mostly negative. They have no knowledge about this discipline. Public has no exact numbers about future work and income of these students. They usually guess that you will be fast food worker. The public usually thinks that psychology is some sort of mind reading. They usually expect some sort of conclusions without any kind of deeper analysis. If they do not get any conclusions in a few minutes, they start being disappointed.

Points to improve: consistent register and style, clarity (the last paragraph is close to a speaking style)

My first question was can I find some single story in my branch of European Studies? Afterwards my thoughts of this problem solved it. Owing to the subject of Comparison of European Political Sstems. Mr. Lijphrat –political theoretician in his research study distinguished two specific types of the political systems we can observe in the reality of politics. The first one was based on majority – who receives the most of the votes wins, the second was contradictory – proportional – based on the proportional distribution of votes among participated elements. His theory has been very reliable in theoretical class. But reality is different, each country in the world has got their own typical system. Despite the division of systems into two categories, the reality is much more difficult. Systems in various countries include sundry basis on which system works and comes from. We could not say that majority system gives this type of results and proportional that type of results in every single occurrence.
