Nominal Suffixes

-ī- derives adjectives from substantives (often geographical names): *aššurûm* (< aššur-ī-um), f. *aššurītum* “assyrian”; *warkum* “back side”, *warkûm* (< wark-ī-um) “what belongs to the backside, future”, *warkītum*: subst. “future”; *šaggāšûm* “murderous”.

-ū- derives abstracts (f.) from substantivized adjectives and nouns:

qardūtum “heroism”, *qarrādūtum* “heroism”, *šarrūtum* “kingship”.

-ān- individualizing suffix: *šarrāqum* “thief”, *šarrāqānum* “this particular thief”. Other usages are less easily defined: *qaqqadum* “head”, *qaqqadānûm* (-ān-ī-um) “someone having a head, prominent”, *muballiṭānum* “someone who keeps alive, maintainer”.

Adverbial Endings

-um: Locative-Adverbial, not identical with the nom. ending. Old postposition, later replaced by *ina*. Can be combined with genit. suffix pronouns, whereby the *m* of the ending is assimilated to the consonant of the suffix: *qerbum* “in the centre”, *qerbuyya* (< *qerbum-ya*) “in my centre”, *qerbukka* (< *qerbum-ka*) “in your centre”.

-ānum (-ān+um.). Used for adverbs: *warkānum* “later, afterwards”, *šaplānum* “beneath”.

-iš: Terminative-Adverbial. Old postposition, later replaced by *ana*: *dāriš* “for ever”. Sometimes combined with *ina* or other prep.: *ana/ina dāriš ūmī* “for ever”, *ištu labīriš* “for a long time”. Can be combined with suffix pronouns: *rigmiška* “on your call”, *puḥriššunu* “in their assembly”.

-(an)iš (-ān+iš) “in the manner of, like”: *iliš* “like a god”, *rīmāniš* “like a wild bull”.

-iš(am): *anniš(am)* “hither”, *ulliš(am)* “thither”, *ayyiš(am)* “whither?”. Distributives: *ūmišam* “daily”, *warḥišam* “monthly”, *šattišam* “yearly”.

-am: sometimes the acc. ending *-am* is used for adverbs: *šumēlam* “left”, *imittam* “right”.

The adverbs (*-um*, *-ānum*, *-iš*) that are combined with nouns or pronouns in the genitive function as preposition (*qerbuššu* “in his centre”).
