


Středověké divadlo mimo církev



Since you and our brethren who accompanied you departed, I have been anxious, having heard no news about how your journey has prospered. However, when almighty God has brought you to our most reverent brother bishop Augustine, tell him what I have decided after long consideration of the case of the English: that by no means should the shrines of idols in that nation be destroyed [*fana idolorum ... minime destrui debeant*], but only the idols within them. Let holy water be sprinkled on these shrines, altars be constructed, relics be placed, so that the shrines, if they be well built, might be converted from the cult of demons to the worship of the true God. Thus, when the people see that their shrines have not been destroyed they will banish error from their hearts and recognising and adoring the true God, they will be more inclined to come to the places they are accustomed to . . .⁸³
