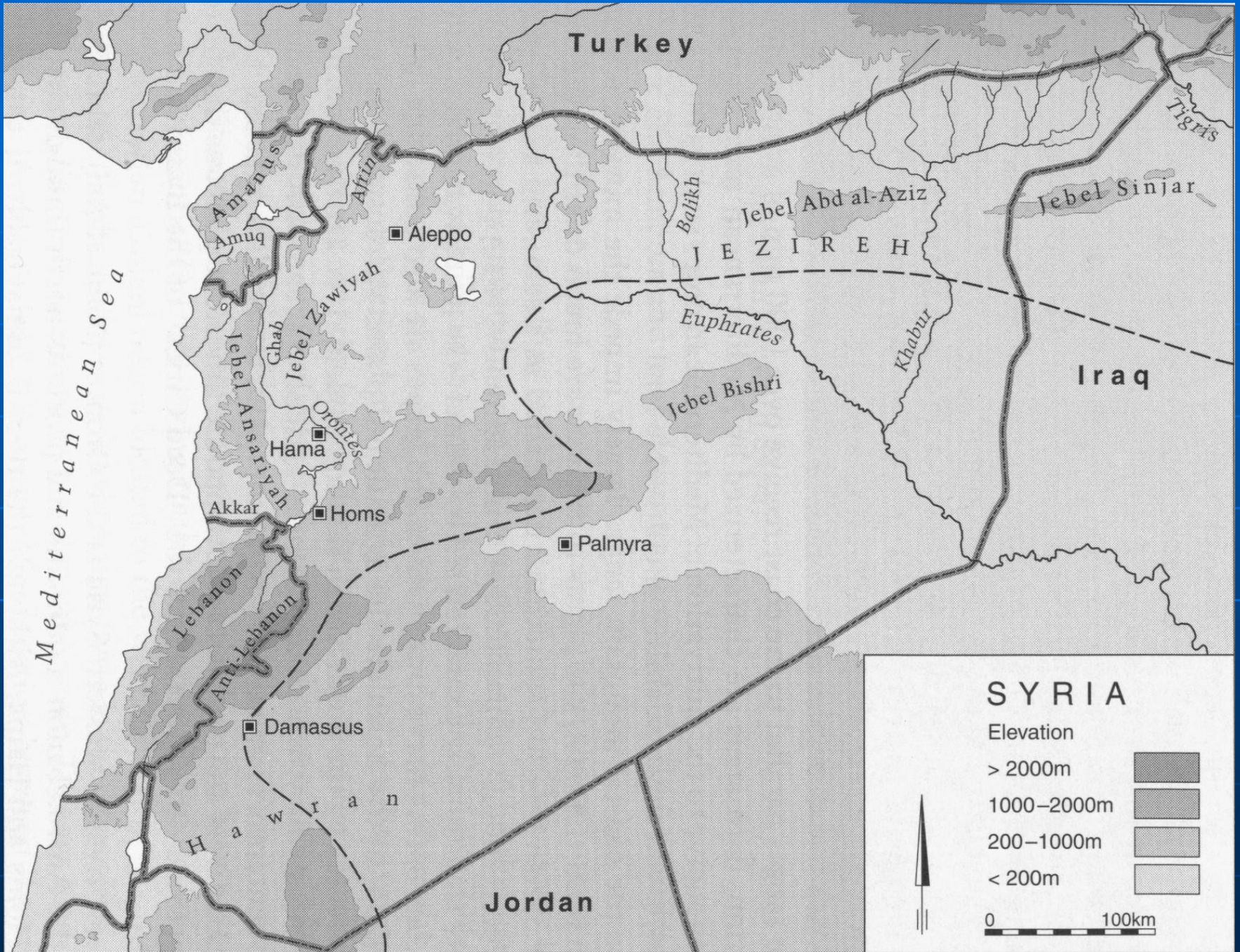

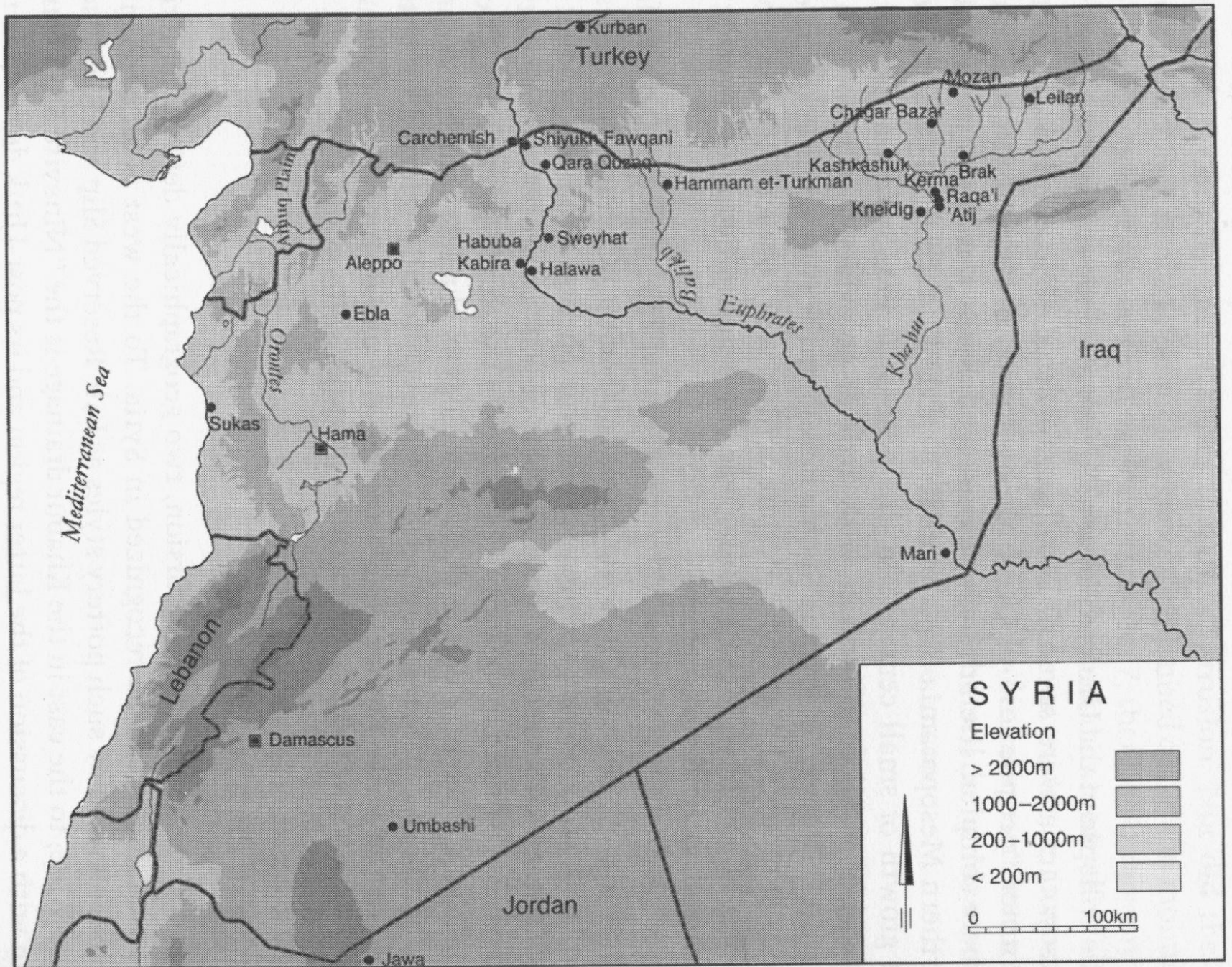

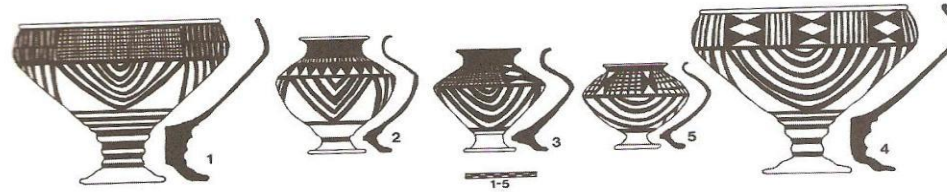

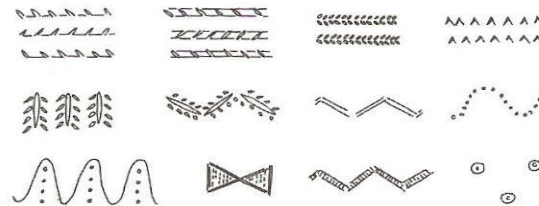
Distribution of Ninevite 5 pottery (green), Khirbet Kerak ware (pink) and Scarlet Ware (orange)



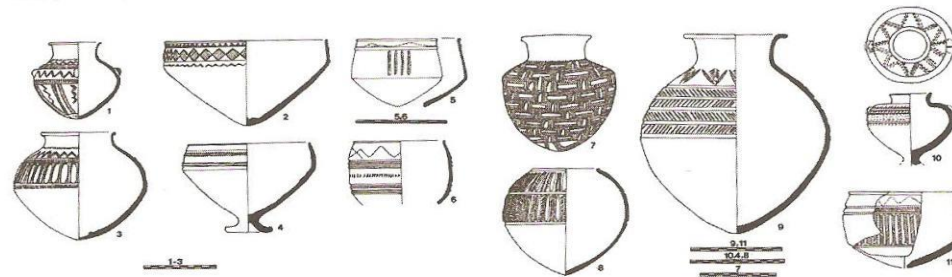

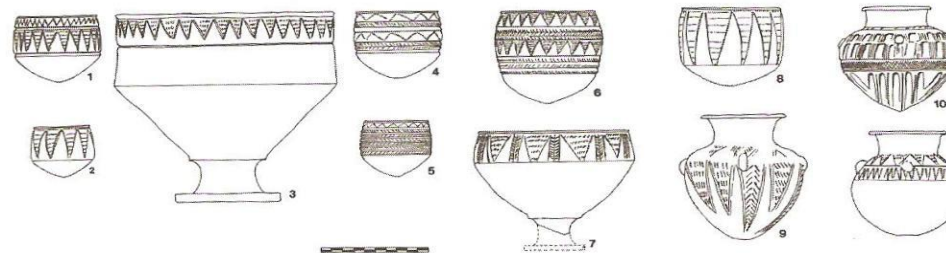

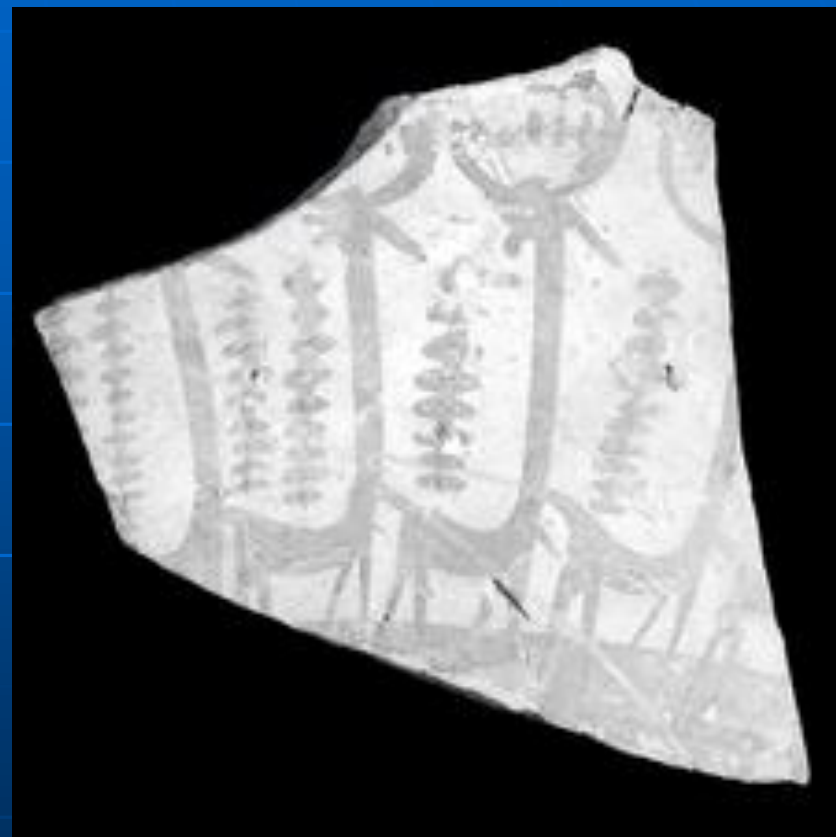

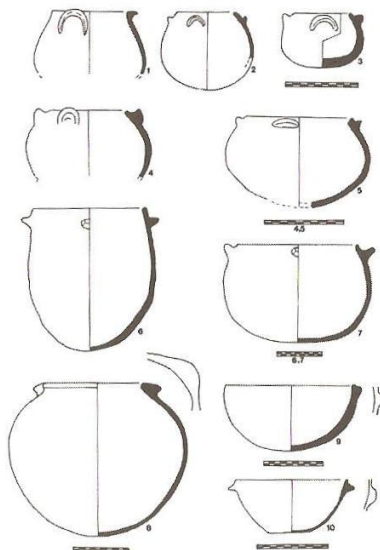

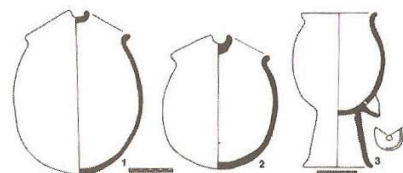

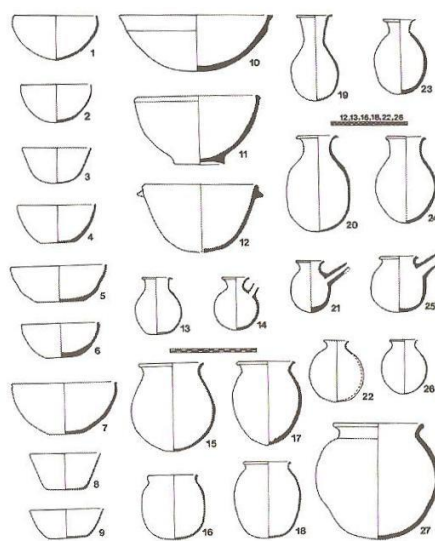

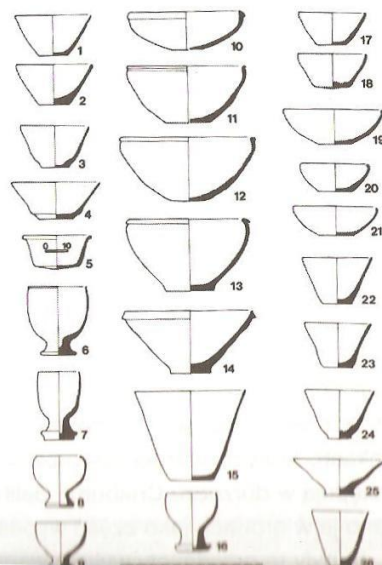


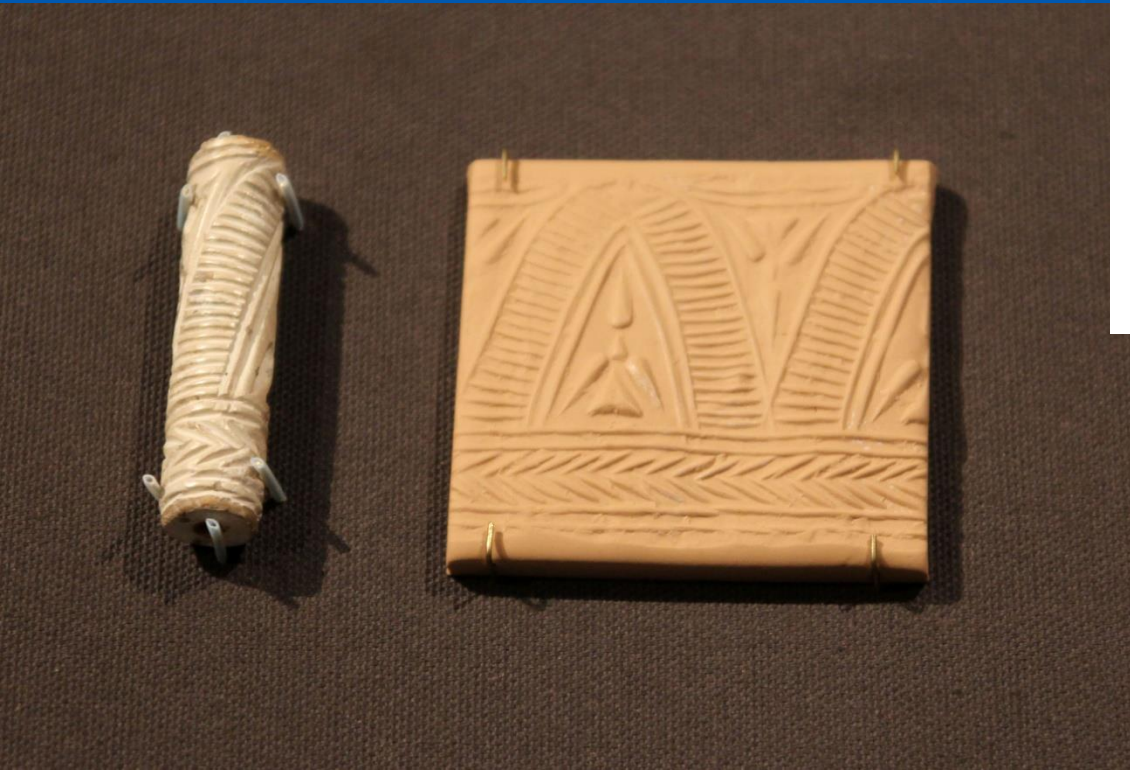

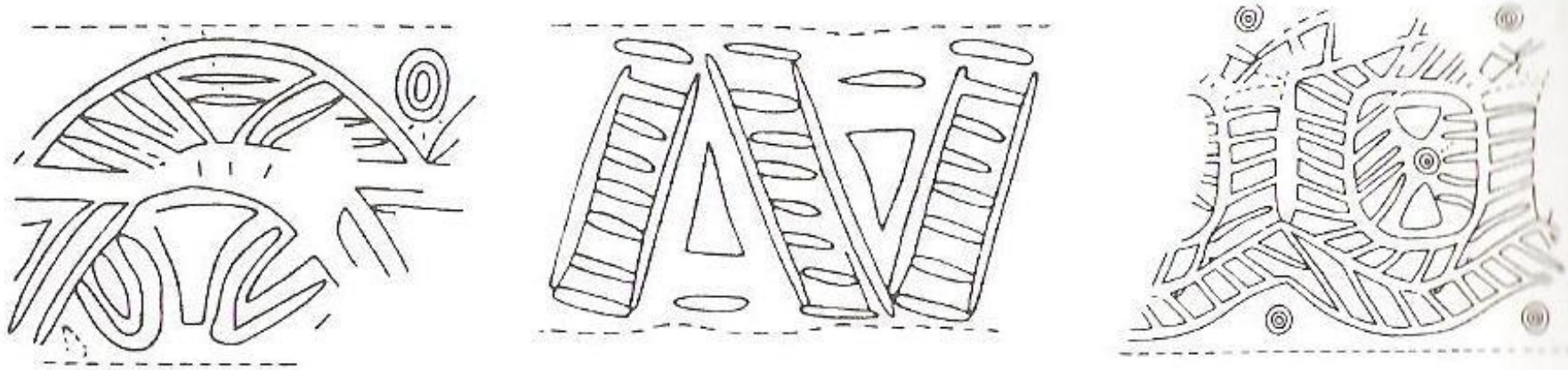
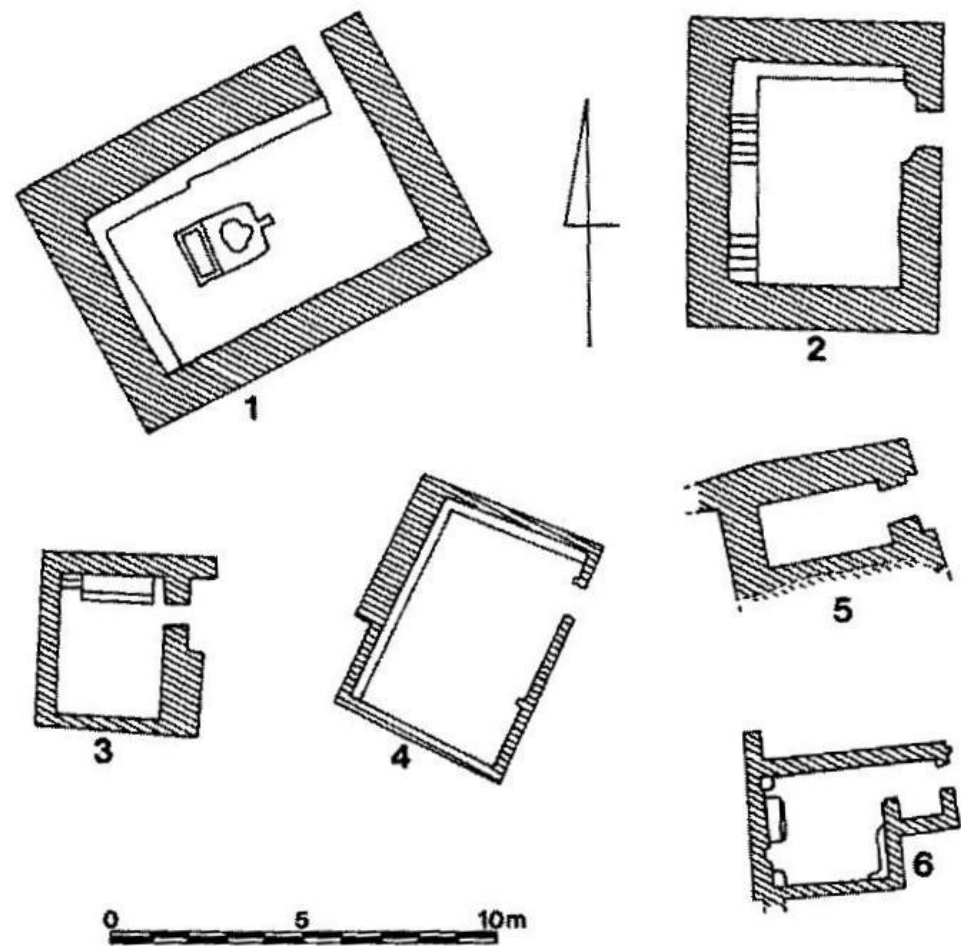


Fig. 7.4 Glazed steatite (“Piedmont Jemdet Nasr”) cylinder sealings from Brak.

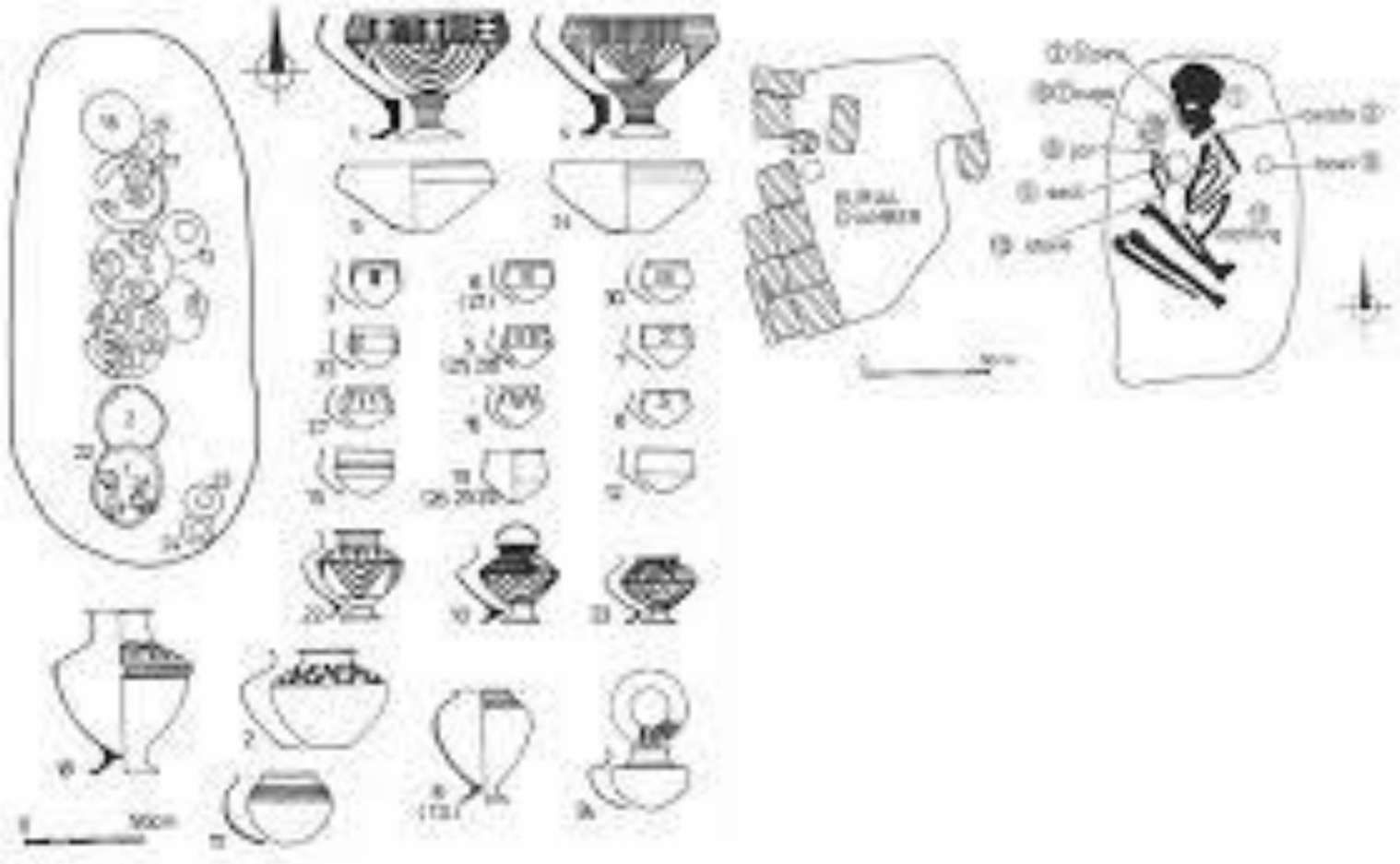

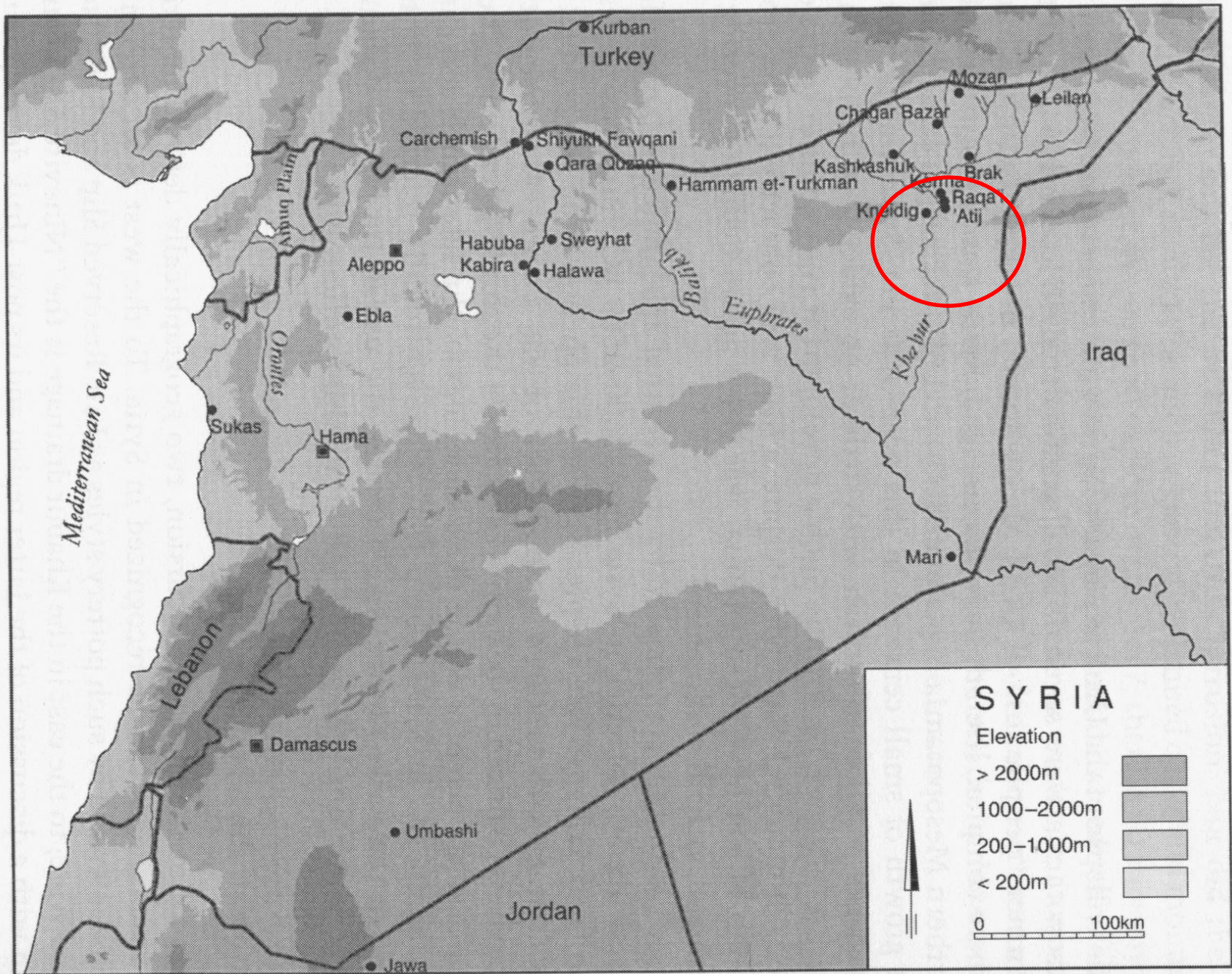
