


# Distribution of Ninevite 5 pottery (green), Khirbet Kerak ware (pink) and Scarlet Ware (orange)
















Fig. 7.4 Glazed steatite ("Piedmont Jemdet Nasr") cylinder sealings from Brak.



Plans of temples from the Upper Khabur region dated to Early Jezireh II and III periods (Ninevite 5 period)











Fig. 7.7 Raqa'i level 3.
