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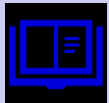

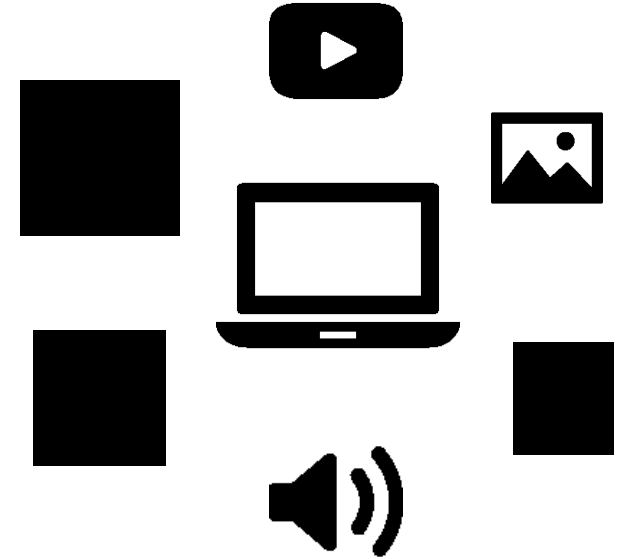

Why

Electronic resources 101

- “all in one”
- curated and (should be) **trustworthy**
 - peer-reviewed materials
 - library / provider curation
- basic and advanced search options
- browsing (e.g. thesauri)

Strategies

- use precise **keywords**
 - topic description
 - combinations
- start with **specific** resource / query
 - e.g. relevant source you already know
- start **broadly** and refine later
 - refining queries with wildcards and booleans
 - refining results with database / search engine specific filters
- browse



Tip 1: controlled vocabularies / thesauri

- browsing tools
- selected terms for describing database content
- thesaurus has hierarchy
- usually in subject-specific databases
- example: [EBSCOhost web](#)

Tip 2: refining queries

- "" for exact phrase

- "art brut"

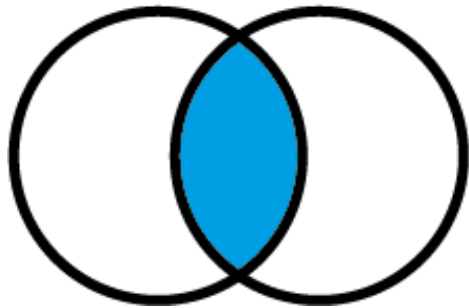
- * asterisk ? question mark (wildcards)

- wom?an = woman OR women

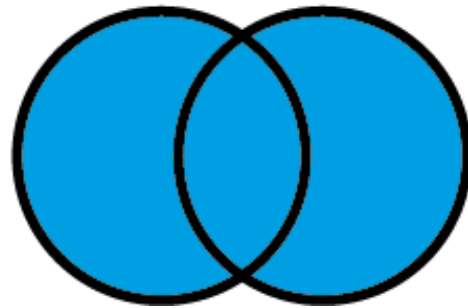
- futur* = futur**ism** OR futur**istic** OR futur**ists** OR future

Tip 3: booleans

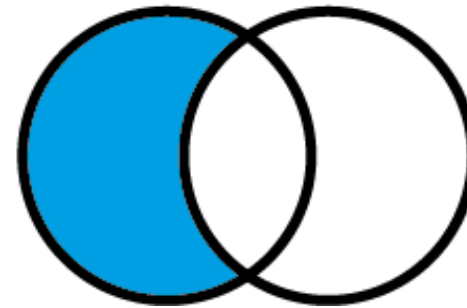
AND



OR



NOT



- art **AND** society (both terms)
- art **OR** artists (at least one of the terms)
- art **NOT** digital (without the second term)

Tip 4: citation management tools

- one place for organizing all your citations
- desktop or web apps
- free or paid
- personal or shared libraries
- plug-ins for browsers and text editors
- different functions: notes, file upload, tags, ...
- e.g. [Citace PRO](#), [Zotero](#), [Mendeley](#), and [many more](#)
