




A: 那你喜欢唱歌吗？ Do you like to sing?


B: 我(不)喜欢唱歌。 I (don't)like singing.

To solicit someone's opinion, we can ask 好吗 after stating an idea or suggestion.

- 你为什么没有吃晚餐？

Nǐ wèishénme méiyǒu chī wǎncān?

- 因为 _____，所以 _____。

Yīnwéi _____, suǒyǐ _____.

- 那我们晚上吃中国菜好吗？

The basic word order in a Chinese sentence is as follows:

Subject (agent of the action)	Adverbial (time, place, manner, etc.)	Verb	Object (receiver of the action)

Affirmative + Negative (A-not-A) Questions (I)

Besides adding the question particle 吗 (ma) to a declarative sentence, another common way of forming a question in Chinese is to repeat the verb or adjective in its affirmative and negative form.

• 你忙吗？

Nǐ máng ma?

• 你忙不忙？

Nǐ máng bùmáng?

• 请问王律师今天有没有事？

Qǐngwèn wánglǜshī jīntiān yǒu meiyǒu shì?

• 请问王律师今天有事吗？

Qǐngwèn wánglǜshī jīntiān yǒushì ma?

Affirmative + Negative (A-not-A) Questions

In this type of question there can be no adverbials before the verb other than time words as in (1) and (2).

1. 你明天去不去？

→ 你明天去吗 ?

2. 她今天晚上看不看电视？

→ 她今天晚上看电视吗 ?

Affirmative + Negative (A-not-A) Questions

If there is an adverbial--such as 很(hěn, very), 都 (dōu, all), or 常常(chángcháng, often)--before the verb, the 吗 type question must be used instead, as in (3), (4), and (5).

3. 他们都是学生吗？ *他们是不是学生？
4. 你常常看电影吗？ *你常常看不看电影？
5. 王医生很忙吗？ *王医生很忙不忙？

Affirmative + Negative (A-not-A) Questions

If there is more than one verb, the question form applies to the first verb, as seen in (6) and (7).

6. 你想不想跳舞？ *你想跳不跳舞？
7. 你的同学去不去打球？
*你的同学去打不打球？

还 hái

also; too; as well

As an adverb, 还 (hái) indicates that the action or situation denoted by the verb involves someone or something else in addition to what has already been mentioned.

- 我喜欢吃中国菜，还喜欢吃美国菜。

wǒ xǐhuān chī zhōngguócài, hái xǐhuān chī měiguócài.

- 你认识谁？(3)

Nǐ rènshí shuí?

A:白英爱，你周末喜欢做什么？

Báiyīngài, nǐ zhōumò xǐhuan zuòshénme?

B:我喜欢打球、看电视。你呢？

Wǒ xǐhuān dǎqiú, kàndiànshì. Nǐ ne?

A:我喜欢唱歌、跳舞，还喜欢听音乐。你也喜欢看书，对不对？

Wǒ xǐhuān chànggē, tiàowǔ, hái xǐhuan tīngyīnyuè. Nǐ yě xǐhuan
B:对，有的时候也喜欢看书。kànshū. Duìbuduì?

Duì, yǒude shíhòu yě xǐhuan kànshū.

A:你喜欢不喜欢看电影？

Nǐ xǐhuan bùxǐhuan kàndiànyǐng?

B:喜欢。我周末常常看电影。

Xǐhuan. Wǒ zhōumò chángcháng kàndiànyǐng.

A:那我们今天晚上去看一个外国电影，怎么样？我请客。

Nà wǒmen jīntiān wǎnshang qù kàn yíge wàiguó diànyǐng,
zěnmeyàng? Wǒ qǐngkè.

B:为什么你请客？

Wèishénme nǐ qǐngkè?

A:因为昨天你请我吃饭，所以今天我请你看电影。
