2. **Working life** – carrier/family/work: working conditions, job prospects, working colleagues, housework...
3. **Family life:** spouse, children parents, siblings, relatives...
4. **Education** – personal/children's: school, adult courses, classmates, teachers..
5. **Wealth:** money, income, car, property, jewellery...
6. **Health:** physical and mental, well-being, food, fitness...
7. **Religion:** practicing a religion, freedom of worship...
8. **Leisure:** relaxation, hobbies, sports, entertainment...
9. **Self-development:** personality, self-confidence, talent...
10. **Housing:** living conditions, size of flat, amenities...
11. **Media:** newspapers, magazines, radio, TV, computers....
12. **Politics:** policies, elections, votes....
13. **Consumer goods:** variety, price, quality and quantity of goods and services...
14. **Public utilities:** electricity, water, sewerage, **waste management**, telephones...
15. **Transport:** commuting time, public transport, parking costs of cars...
16. **Health care:** medical facilities, clinics, doctors and nurses...
17. **Environment:** air and water quality, noise, nature areas...
18. **Public safety:** security, crime rate, ease of travel and movement...
