Stano Pekár



- produced by Elsevier
- currently the largest scientific database
- 16 000 peer-review journals (4 100 for Life sciences)
- 300 books, 700 proceedings
- 23 million patents
- since 1960 but mainly from 1997

- Author Identifier to distinguish between authors with the same name
- Affiliation Identifier to identify organisation with all its research output
- Citation Tracker to find, check and track citation data
- h-index to evaluate research performance
- number of citations to most cited papers by an author
- PatentCites to track how patents are practically applied
- WebCites to track the influence of peer-reviewed research on literature

• integration with 2collab – free collaborative research tool to network, collaborate and share information with colleagues
