INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE END-OF-TERM PRESENTATIONS in MAY 2016

- Find partners and make groups of four (or three) students.
- The aim of the task is delivering a team presentation + preparing a poster about your topic.
- Choose a topic about a problem in society or environment where geographers can offer some help or a solution.
- FORM of presentation: 8 -10-minute presentation in class, structured, each student presents a part of the topic, be prepared for a discussion listeners must ask questions
- FORM of the poster: preferably word document, 1 page, posters will be made available in IS for other students to read before the presentations are delivered
- Deadline for submitting the posters: 1 May 2016, to the file in IS odevzdávárny
- Presentations will be delivered in classes in weeks 11 and 12 (note: end of my course is May 11th)

The task is a compulsory part of the course. It will be assessed, pass mark is always 60%.

ASSESSMENT OF PRESENTATIONS

- 10% structure introduction, main part, ending
- 20% a reasonable topic, clearly described and **analysed** for the listeners to understand well
- 10% good and relevant slides
- 10% balanced contribution of team members in speaking
- 20% good English, signalling language (e.g. Firstly, Now I'll hand over to Jan. In conclusion,...)
- 20% inviting audience to ask questions, dealing with questions (i.e. answering, reacting)
- 10% each student must ask a question about one of the presentations in the class reading the posters in advance will give you some ideas what to ask about, thus you collect more points for your team

ASSESSMENT OF POSTERS

- 15% good layout
- 15% brief but informative
- 20% clear descriptions in good English (grammar, spelling, terminology)
- 15% relevant pictures, if necessary- explanations of some special terms
- 15% including sources
- 20% function if it works well, if it introduces the topic clearly to non-expert academic audience
