- meet
- am meeting
- have met
- met

9. He said that he ..... the next day.

- will come
- would come
- was coming

10. The letter ..... yesterday.

- posted
- was posted
- had posted

11. The teacher ..... the lazy boy.

- scold
- scolded
- scolding

12. He ..... president of the club.

- elected
- was elected
- has elected
