### HOUSE

#### Types of houses

1. Detached house	A. joined to another house by 1 shared wall being one of a pair of joined houses
2. Semidetached house	B. a modern house with 2 or 3 floors, esp. suited to be built on a small piece of land in a town
3. Terraced house	C. a tall block of flats or offices
4. Bungalow	D. a house on the edge of a town, either standing by itself or joined to another and having a garden (usu. built before 1914)
5. Villa <b>GB</b>	E. a large house, usu. belonging to a wealthy person
6. Mansion	F. a small house or set of rooms built on a top of a tall building often considered very desirable to live in
7. Block of flats <b>GB</b> apartment block <b>US</b>	G. a small house, esp. in the country
8. Tower block	H. a very tall city building
9. Flat <b>AE</b> apartment	I. large building divided into separate parts (flats or offices) office block
10. Cottage	J. set of rooms esp. on one floor, including a kitchen and bathroom; usu. one of many such sets in a building or block
11. Town house	K. a row of houses joined to each other
12. Skyscraper	L. a type of house which is all on one level no stairs
13. Penthouse	M. separate, not connected on any side with any other building
