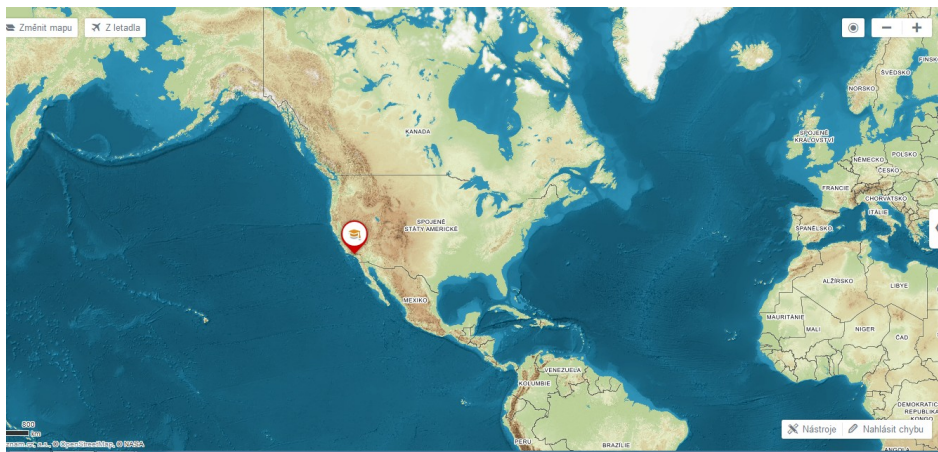


TRUE OR FALSE ABOUT YOU?
